The **second event** will focus more specifically on Faculty Learning Communities. In addition to explaining the role of Faculty Learning Communities in the GEP Assessment process, we will begin forming Faculty Learning Communities.

These sessions are open to the whole campus, but should be especially relevant to any instructor who is offering a Foundation Level course during Fall 2013, as this is the focus of our assessment efforts this year. (Next year, assessment will focus on all Investigation Level courses.)
