Schmeeckle Reserve Ecological Restoration Fellowship/Crew Leader

The primary mission of Schmeeckle Reserve is to protect, manage, and restore native ecological communities of central Wisconsin. This paid fellowship/supervisory position manages ecological restoration projects in the campus natural area. It provides valuable experience in supervising a work crew, identifying aquatic and terrestrial invasive species, researching invasive control and restoration methods, developing and implementing management plans, and providing education to diverse audiences.

Duties:

- Research, plan, and develop restoration management plans
- Supervise a crew of 3-4 student employees to assist in restoration efforts
- Identify and map exotic invasive species populations
- Implement invasive species control techniques in the field (manual removal, chemical treatment, prescribed burns, etc.)
- Implement habitat restoration practices in the field (tree removal, native seeding and planting, protecting areas from deer browse)
- Coordinate and supervise volunteers to assist in restoration projects
- Educate students, residents, visitors, and volunteers about restoration management
- Participate in weekly Schmeeckle Reserve supervisor meetings
- Other duties as assigned by the Schmeeckle Reserve director

Research Project:

• In addition to the above duties, the fellow will plan and develop an independent research project in coordination with the Fellowship Academic Coordinator(s).

Requirements:

- Undergraduate student at UW-Stevens Point enrolled in summer or fall 2023 courses
- Strong interest in enhancing native habitats through invasive species control.
- Strong work ethic and ability to work independently.
- Possess or willingness to obtain a Wisconsin Pesticide Applicator Training (PAT) license
- Comfortable speaking to and engaging the public and decision makers.
- Ability to work outside in all types of weather and temperatures.

Pay & Commitment:

- Pay: \$12.00 per hour
- Dates: Ideally April 2023 to May 2024 (negotiable)
- Hours: 10-20 hours per week during the academic year, 30-40 hours per week during the summer season
