SPRING 2026 ADVISING APPROACHES

All students are required to meet with their adviser in order to register for Spring 2026. You will be sent an email from your Academic Adviser in the next couple weeks that will provide an invite to set up your appointment.

If you are a new student, make sure you have completed the following as applicable:

-  • If you earned any credit through **AP or IB exams**, and you have not done so, send in an office copy of your AP scores or IB scores to the UWSP Admissions Office.
-  • If you earned **any transfer credit, including dual-credit** courses in high school, make sure you have sent your official COLLEGE transcript to the UWSP Admissions Office.
-  • Set up your Peer Advising appointment - check your UWSP email for the invitation to sign up.
-  • Review Pointer's Launch modules 2 and 3 to learn how to prepare for your Spring 2026 advising appointment, and how to register.

LAST DAY TO W-DROP FIRST 8-WEEK CLASSES

The W-drop deadline for first 8-week classes is **this week Friday, October 3.**

What is a W-drop?

A class that is W-dropped remains on the student's transcript with the grade of a "W". "W" grades do not have any impact on GPA, and can be a wise choice if passing a class is not possible. Contact your Academic Adviser if considering a W-drop so you are aware of any other implications.
