
Validating Your Schedule

Even though a class is in your shopping cart doesn't mean you can enroll into it. Some classes will have prerequisites, be reserved for certain student populations, or may fill up by the time you can register. Some examples include:



Sections with an "H" in their number which are reserved for students in the honors program

General Education - Bachelor-Section



You can check if you can register for a class by clicking on the "Validate" button on your Shopping Cart within Schedule Builder.

The "Validate" button will also alert you if you have any holds on your account that prevent registration!

WINTERIM REGISTRATION THIS WEEK - OCT 27

Winterim is a class session where students can take up to three credits between January 2 and January 17. Most winterim classes are 100% online and can be helpful to catch up or get ahead on credits. However, be aware they are highly accelerated, requiring significant daily work throughout the session.

Your "Advisor Hold" will not prevent you from registering for Winterim, however your "Registration Hold" will! If choosing to enroll into a winterim course, make sure you have completed the "To-Do" task called, "Required Registration Actions" within the "Tasks" tile in accessPoint.
