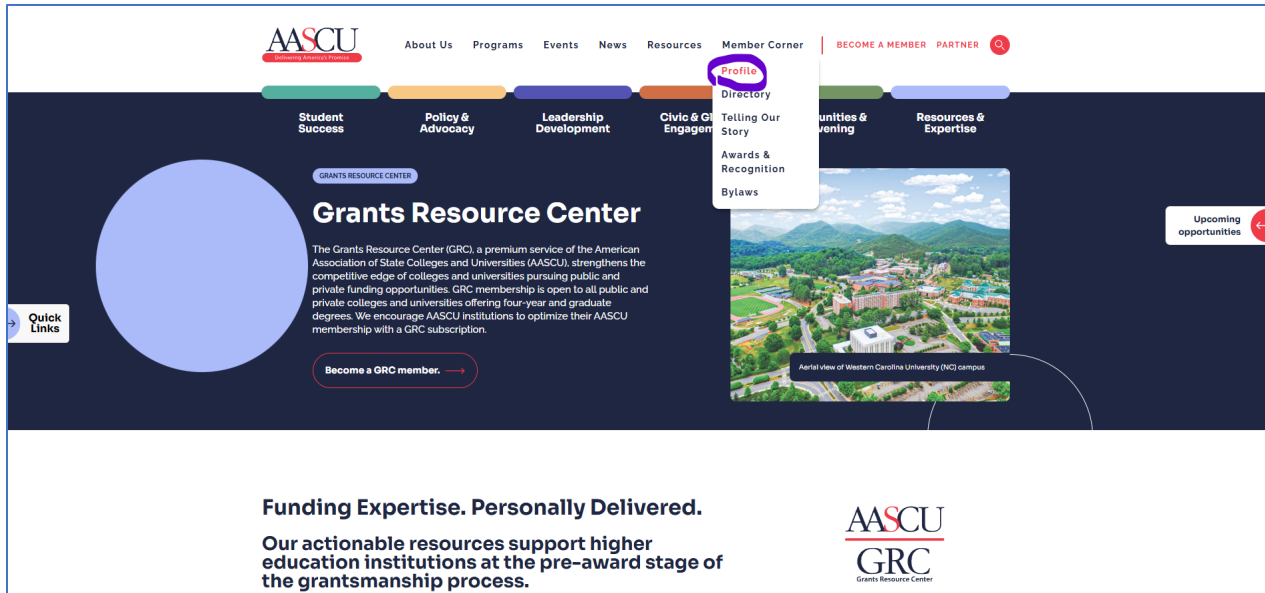


Directions for Grant Resource Center (GRC) Account Creation and Funding Searches & Alerts

Individuals create their own individual accounts for access to GRC. General institutional or office logins are no longer current. For help with account creation, contact GRCMembership@aascu.org and note you are with membership institution University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point.

Account Creation

1. Go to <https://aascu.org/resources-expertise/grc>. Hover over Member Corner at the top to click Profile.



2. Click Create a new account.

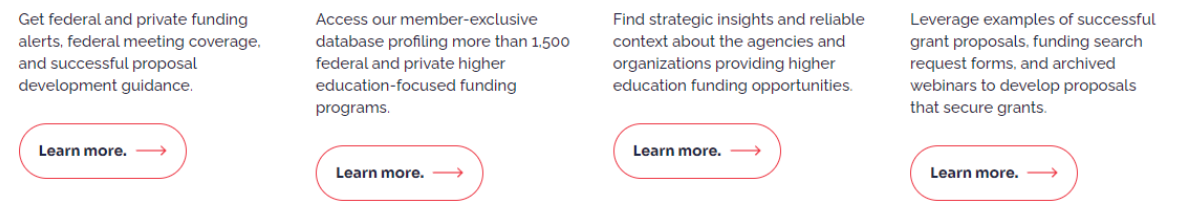

1. Once an account is created (see steps above), navigate to the Grants Resource Center page (<https://aascu.org/resources-expertise/grc/>). Then scroll and click “Learn more about our resources”.

2. To search grant opportunities, click “Learn More” under GrantSearch, then “Discover funding opportunities”. Login again if prompted. The page that follows may take a few moments to load.

4. In the example below, we are broadly searching for Forestry and Water Resources Management grants. Click Search to view the grant opportunities listed for the areas specified. The options that appear can be sorted by Deadline if preferred.

Click on an opportunity listed to see a description and link to further information and materials from the granting agency.

Note it is best practice to contact UWSP’s Office of Research and Sponsored Programs (orsp@uwsp.edu) 2-4 weeks prior to a grant deadline with a link or guidelines to the opportunity you are interested in applying for. UWSP requires several levels of approvals prior to grant application submission. This lead time allows for our office to work with you as you assemble the required documents and leaves 1-2 weeks to obtain UWSP approvals (and complete revisions if they are requested). We look forward to working with you!

5. There’s an option to create an email alert of the search you just created, then GRC will automatically email you when a new opportunity becomes available within the categories you selected.

Click “Save as Alert” on the results page, then give the alert a title and optional description, then Save. The page will now take you to all categories saved for email notification, GRC calls these “Faculty Alerts”. You can also Create Alert from the Faculty Alerts page as well.
