

Transfer Guide between the Parks and Natural Resources AAS Degree at Kirkwood Community College and the majors in the

College of Natural Resources at the University of Wisconsin – Stevens Point (UWSP)

If a student completes the Parks and Natural Resources AAS degree at KCC, they will transfer up to 63 credits to UWSP. If they do not complete their entire program at KCC, their credits will be reviewed on an individual basis and may not transfer. If the student changes into a UWSP major outside of the CNR or transfers to a different UW institution, the credits are not transferable unless a similar agreement exists.

The following guide lists the required courses for the Parks and Natural Resources AAS Degree and the equivalent courses at UWSP. Below are estimates of credits remaining for completion of a Bachelor's degree in the CNR various majors (actual total number depends on elective credits, general degree requirements & math placement). Thirteen additional CNR majors are also available for completion.

- Wildlife Ecology @ 88 credits plus summer field camp
- Fisheries @ 102 credits plus summer field camp
- Environmental Education & Interpretation @ 79 credits plus summer field camp
- Forest Management or Forest Recreation @ 89 credits plus summer field camp
- General Resource Management @ 78 credits plus summer field camp ^
- Environmental Law Enforcement @ 74 credits plus summer field camp and
12 credits of recruit school
