PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

This articulation agreement provides the opportunity for NTC students enrolled in any of the three Human Services Associates of Applied Science Degree programs to be awarded credit toward the Family and Consumer Sciences Bachelor of Science Degree- Child Youth & Family Studies track, as listed in the following charts. NTC students completing the Human Services AAS Degree will be exempt from completing a minor as part of their Family & Consumer Sciences BS Degree. NTC Human Services AAS degree credits will substitute for this major requirement.

PROGRAM-TO-PROGRAM TRANSFER COURSES: Please see attachments A, B, and C.

SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

1. Human Services AAS Degree graduates must have earned a minimum grade point average of 2.5 for admission to the FCS-CYFS major (2.75 needed to graduate for FCS).
2. The acceptance of credits applies only to this Program to Program Articulation.
3. For acceptance of equivalent courses, NTC courses must have been completed within the last 5 years. Beyond this period of time, course equivalents will be assessed on an individual basis.
4. This agreement is subject to review if either NTC or UWSP undergoes curriculum revision **OR** within five years of the origination date of this agreement, whichever occurs earlier.
