Transfer Agreement

Between

The University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point Division of Interior Architecture

And

Fox Valley Technical College Associate Degree Program in Interior Design

Program to Program Articulation Agreement

Rationale:

This agreement between Fox Valley Technical College (FVTC) (hereafter the sending institution), and the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point (UWSP) (hereafter the receiving institution) is in accordance with UW System Undergraduate Transfer Policy 135 (formerly ACIS 6.0). This agreement builds on, and further supports the intent of, the UW System Universal Credit Transfer Agreement (UCTA) among all University of Wisconsin System institutions and Wisconsin Technical College System Districts. The main purpose is to provide a smooth transfer of credit from a relevant two-year Associate Degree in Interior Design to a four-year Bachelor of Fine Arts in Interior Architecture program at UWSP. The sending institution two-year curriculum, in providing students with solid foundational technical skills and project experiences in design, corresponds appropriately with the receiving institution's foundational two-year curriculum and is an appropriate education in design for being able to transition into and successfully complete the receiving institution's professionally-accredited Interior Architecture program.

Terms of the Agreement:

- Both institutions agree to maintain accreditation by the Higher Learning Commission, and any other accreditations currently in existence pertaining to degree programs articulated via the transfer agreement, including for the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, Interior Architecture accreditation from the Council of Interior Design Accreditation (CIDA) and the National Association of Schools of Art and Design (NASAD).
- 2. For students to have the credit transfer applied, they must have completed their Associate Degree from Fox Valley Technical College and be admitted to and enrolled at the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, with the declared Interior Architecture major.
- 3. Upon completion of, or within the final semester of completing their AAS degree from FVTC, students wishing to transfer under this agreement must submit a digital or printed Transfer Portfolio to the Division of Interior Architecture with a Letter of Intent to Transfer under the articulated agreement contained within. The Transfer Portfolio submitted is to show select primary examples of student design work on projects from within the AAS curriculum and during internships as applicable. The samples selected are at the discretion of the transfer student, yet should be representative of their

academic progress. The Division of Interior Architecture reserves the right to request more documentation from a student. The final cumulative grade point average (GPA) from Fox Valley Technical College must be at or above a 2.75 in Design courses, which is consistent with the Interior Architecture Professional Sequence admittance standard per the UWSP handbook.

- 4. Upon completion of an Associate Degree of Applied Science in Interior Design (AAS) and/or Kitchen and Bath Design (AAS) at Fox Valley Technical College, and having completed the design courses listed in Table 1, and upon admission to the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point, students will receive equivalent credit transfer for design-related courses in the Interior Architecture (BFA) program as specified in Table 1.
- 5. This agreement shall be in effect from the date of its acceptance by the governing bodies of the UW System and Fox Valley Technical College respectively and is subject to a consistent five-year review cycle. At the time of each five-year review period or at any time between periods, the agreement may be amended formally with acceptance of both parties if it is deemed that changes are necessary. Either party may terminate the agreement if it is deemed that significant changes are necessary and a new agreement will be developed at that time, if deemed appropriate. Any changes to this agreement or termination proceedings must take place and be in effect with at least two full academic year's notice and be completed by May 15th of the preceding two-year academic period. This clause is in place to ensure that the academic plan of a student who is enrolled under the current agreement at either institution is not negatively impacted.
- 6. This agreement builds on and further supports the intent of the UW System Universal Credit Transfer Agreement (UCTA) among all University of Wisconsin System institutions and Wisconsin Technical College System Districts. All general education transfer credits must be coordinated between institutions for any specific general education courses and students along with their advisors are to verify any such credit transfers or other UW institution requirements prior to enrollment in a course or program of study. It is advisable that students and advisors use the credit transfer tools provided by the UW system and regularly monitor such General Education Articulations which may periodically change. This agreement does not specifically relate to, or reference any specific, general education course transfers.
- 7. Upon admission to UWSP, all transfer students will be assigned an academic advisor to assist in enrolling in UWSP courses, and in making a plan to complete all Interior Architecture Courses at UWSP, and any additional General Education Program requirements for eventual graduation from the University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point with a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Interior Architecture. Students enrolled at FVTC may consult with UWSP academic advisors at any time during their AAS program to make an academic transfer plan.
