A Few Reminders...

GENERAL ITEMS

1. ASQ-3 paperwork was recently placed in all family mailboxes. The UCLCC utilizes the ASQ-3 with all families. The ASQ-3 is a developmental screener that aids the teachers in getting a better picture on where families see their child's development is at and how things are potentially similar/different in a child's behavior at home vs. school.

Teachers will note this information at the mandatory fall conferences on November 18.

- 2. Breakfast is provided daily. If you would like your child to have a small snack beforehand, please sit with your child at a table until they have finished before leaving.
- 3. Each child's nap basket and cubby basket must fit all of their individual items WITHOUT touching another child's basket/items. The center provides a sheet & blanket. Stuffed animals, sleeping bags, etc. tend to be too large for the baskets.
- 4. Items from home: toys, jewelry, books, etc. should remain at home. These items become an issue between the children & are often lost/broken.
- 5. The center is only licensed to provide care until 5:30pm & not before 7:30am. Be sure you are NOT signing your child in before 7:30am. Please make sure you are picking up your children AND THEN signing them out. Plan to arrive early enough to have time to go and get your children PRIOR to clocking out.

ATTENDANCE RECORDS

Families must sign their child in/out in our automated ProCare software program upon arrival and departure daily. Each family has a 4-digit pin for the system to enter on the IPad. This compliance is a state law requiring the center to have an accurate count & whereabouts of children in attendance at all times. A penalty fee is enforced for not following this policy.

MATERIALS COLLECTION CART

As you enter off the elevator and to your right you will find a small white cart labeled "Materials Collection Cart." Written on there are specific items the classrooms teachers are requesting to complete various projects and learning activities in their classrooms. If you have any of these items that may otherwise find their way into the trash, we ask you to please bring them in and place on the cart. Items requested will change monthly. SAFETY & SECURITY

In an effort to keep the children of the UCLCC as safe as possible, we ask families to please be mindful of the following best practices:

- Do **NOT** share with your children the pin pad code to the doors or allow them to enter the code
- Do **NOT** allow your child to press any of the elevator buttons
- Do **NOT** allow your children to enter your family pin on the sign in/out IPad
- When dropping off/picking up, always keep your child in your sight and sound (please do not leave them unattended even for a brief time to put something away, grab something, etc.). Be sure that you are connecting with a UCLCC staff member when leaving your child here for the day and taking them home for the night.

FAMILY BOARD AREA

In the same area as our Materials Collection Cart is the Family Board Area. This area contains things such as a hardcopy of the monthly newsletter, licensing information, community & center event happenings, & sign-up sheets for things such as potlucks, exam week hours of attendance, etc. The flower container next to this area are pens to utilize when these documents are posted. If there is an event you would like to share with other families, please bring the flyer to the office & we will get it hung in this location for all to see.

FAMILIES HELPFUL TIPS CORNER

Below are a couple of Conscious Discipline items we have been implementing at the center and would encourage you to try/use at home as well. These are just a few "Helpful Words"; things that are helpful to say to children.

Here are a few examples of some of the language to use:

- 1. Teaching a child to be more assertive sounds like this: "Did you like that? Tell your friend, 'I don't like it when you (insert hurtful action), Please (insert new skill)."
- 2. Encouragement sounds like this "You (describe in detail without judgement) so (how the action impacted others). That was helpful! Example: "You picked up the toy so Jill wouldn't step on it. That was helpful."
- 3. A positive way to deal with unwanted behavior is to tell the child what you want. "You can...". We try to notice instead of judge. Example "You wanted to go down the slide, so you pushed Jill out of the way. When you want Jill to move, say "Move Jill". Try it with me. Say "Move Jill".

It is beneficial to practice the desired behavior with an adult. When children are whining or yelling, we say "match your voice to mine". Lets shift our focus from "getting children to do something" to noticing why they are doing what they are doing.
