Her message articulates very meaningfully the benefit this experience can have  $\mathfrak{S}$  Thank you!

"Last year I took a chance and asked if Teacher Elsie would allow me to help in the classroom weekly. To my surprise Thursday's from 3-4 quickly became my favorite hour of the week! Being able to see my daughter and her classmates thrive and grow throughout the year was incredible. I thought I would be there to help them cut and glue – which we did a lot of, but I was able to also help them foster other classroom skills. friendships. empathy, leadership skills and problem solving skills. It really showed me how much of that growth comes from the support of the classroom, which thrives when parents are involved.





By volunteering, I got to see firsthand how much our presence helps kids feel secure and confident as they face challenges. It also strengthens the connection between home, school, and the community, showing our kids that we care about their education and growth. I was not expecting to have volunteering weekly help ME in my parenting. I was able to learn the language that is used to reinforce those behaviors at home. It gave my daughter something to look forward too each week – she was so proud that I came regularly for her and her school family.

I encourage you to think about volunteering, even just a little bit each week. It really makes a difference in their lives. I hope you get to experience the joy I was able to experience, it changes you for the better!" -A.B.
