Framework for Digital Accessibility

T—Train

Build foundational knowledge of accessibility principles and tools.

- Complete <u>UWSP accessibility training</u>
- Review <u>UWSP</u> and <u>Universities of Wisconsin</u> policies

R—Remove

Eliminate outdated or unused course materials.

- Use TidyUP to delete unused content
- Audit your course for content that is outdated or unnecessary

A—Adjust

Revise existing materials to meet accessibility standards.

- Run UDOIT in Canvas to identify accessibility issues
- Choose your remediation path:
 - Apply what you learned in the UWSP accessibility training
 - Follow along with CITL's Canvas course -Title II: Bite-sized Remediation Guide for step-by-step support

C-Create

Develop new content with accessibility in mind from the start.

- Use accessible templates and tools
- Follow best practices for multimedia and documents
- Test content with accessibility checkers

K—Keep Monitoring

Continuously evaluate and improve accessibility efforts.

- Run UDOIT before the start of each term
- Stay updated on evolving standards and tools
