

# UWSP Zoom Security Update - April 9, 2020



Yesterday evening Zoom announced a series of security enhancements for Zoom apps. Details about the changes for the desktop app are in this [blog posting](#).

One of the more important features is the addition of the **Security Icon to all Zoom hosts and co-hosts** meeting controls in the latest release (version 4.6.10) of the desktop (Mac & Windows), mobile (iOS & Android), iPad, and web client.

The **Security Icon** will provide easy access to the following [in-meeting security options](#):

- [Lock the meeting](#)
- Enable the [Waiting Room](#) (even if it's not already enabled)
- [Remove participants](#)
- Restrict participants' ability to:
  - [Share their screens](#)
  - [Chat in a meeting](#)
  - [Rename themselves](#)
  - [Annotate on the host's shared content](#)

Information Technology will update the Zoom apps on all UWSP managed computers soon. To update the Zoom app on personal computers, visit <https://zoom.us/download> and follow the instructions for your device.

Another important change is that Zoom is changing the web client so "**Only authenticated users can join meetings from the Web client.**" All UWSP students, faculty and staff have access to a licensed Zoom account and can activate it by going to <https://uwsp.zoom.us> and clicking the "Sign-In" button. Guests can sign-up for a free Zoom account by going to <https://zoom.us/freesignup/>.
