

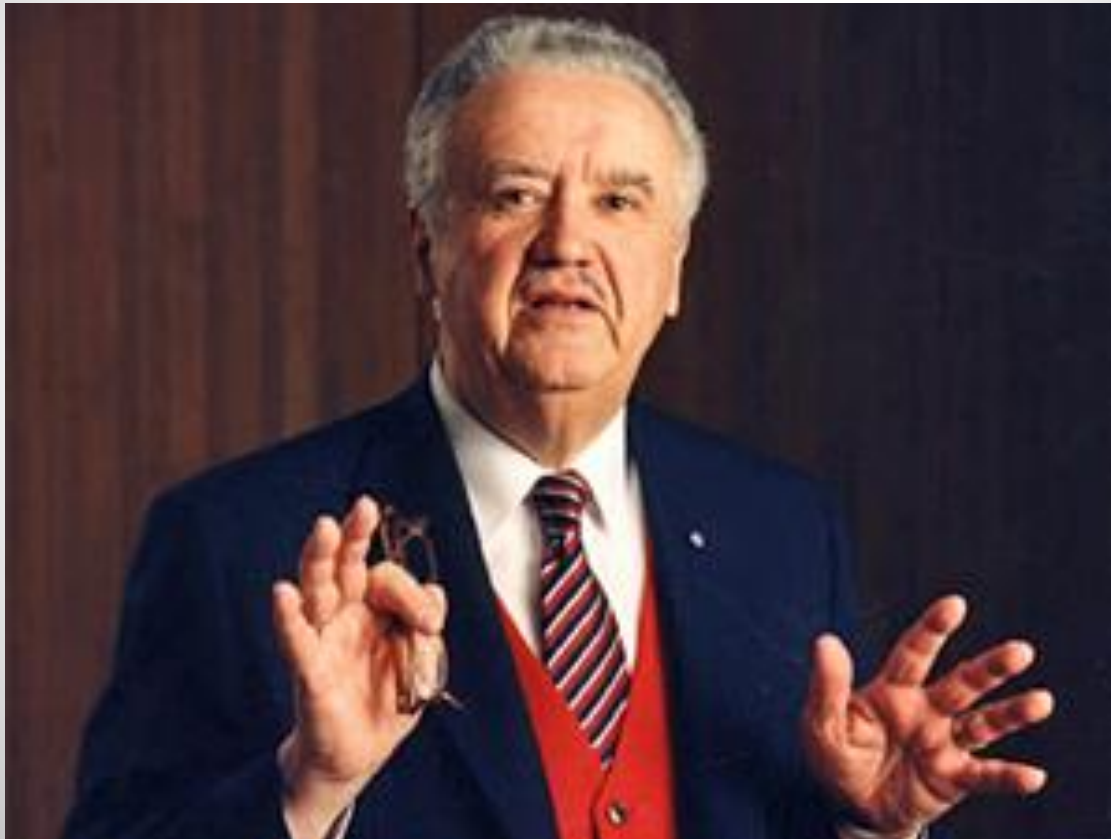

Select Video Editing Programs

Windows Movie Maker

Pros: User friendly, easy to access

Cons: Less features

Apple iMovie

Pros: User friendly, decent features

Cons: More difficult to access

Adobe Premiere Pro

Pros: Numerous features, professional quality

Cons: Less user friendly, might be difficult to access

Tips for Starting Out

- Just do it- don't worry about mastery but instead aim for improvement over time
- Think about data storage and management from the very beginning
- Lynda.com is awesome
- Consider your technical needs- what does the project require?
- Seek out assistance from UWSP Technical Support staff
- Practice using the equipment and video editing software
- Give your class ample time to work on the technical aspects of the project
