

# Legislative Timeline

#### Timeline for state budget development

Fall 2018 Agencies submit budget requests to Governor Feb 2019 Governor announce s Executive Budget Proposal

Governor

June 2010 Legislature can override vetoes (rarely happens)

• State budget is biennial – 2 years (July 2019-June 2021)

# State Budget – Highlights of Gov's Proposal

- Increase County Conservationist funding by \$1.4M
- > 5 positions overseeing CAFOs
- New bureau with 5 scientists. Clean water research
- >\$4M for nonpoint cost share
- >\$1.5M more towards lake and river protection
