Introduction to Shotgun and Archery Shooting



EVENT DESCRIPTION

This is a great opportunity for anyone new to shooting a gun or a bow, as well as for those who want to polish their skills. You will have one-on-one instruction to learn how to safely and comfortably handle a shotgun, and have fun with shooting clay pigeons in the game of trap.

Then move on to the archery range where patient coaches will provide one-on-one instruction to get you hitting 3-D targets in no time.

No experience is necessary and all the equipment - bows, arrows, target firearms, ammunition, ear and eye protection - will be provided. This workshop is designed for beginners but also appropriate for anyone who wants to brush up on their shooting skills.

The workshop will be held at the Hartford Conservation and Gun Club near Pike Lake State Park. Pike lake is a 522-acre, spring-fed kettle lake in the middle of the Kettle Moraine, a strip of glacial landforms which extends through southeast Wisconsin.
