Join us for a safe and fun course that will introduce you to recreational shooting with a variety of firearms and archery equipment.

Participants will learn hands-on firearm safety handling and principles from certified, patient instructors. After you become familiar with the different guns and bows available to shoot during the course, you will head out to the shooting ranges for one-on-one lessons using rifles, shotguns, and modern archery equipment. There will also be an opportunity to shoot handguns for those who would like to.





No experience is necessary and all the equipment - bows, arrows, firearms, ammunition, ear and eye protection - will be provided. This workshop is designed for beginners but also appropriate for anyone who wants to brush up on their shooting skills, or try a gun or bow that they have not had the opportunity to shoot before.

The workshop will be held at the Bill Cook Chapter of the Izaak Walton League property and Conservation Center located just east of Stevens Point. The grounds consist of 147 acres of managed forest with the scenic Plover River passing through it. The large Conservation Center offers meeting space, stone fireplaces and modern restrooms.
