Introduction to Shotguns and Archery



EVENT DESCRIPTION

Join us for a safe and fun course that will introduce you to recreational shooting with shotguns and archery equipment. Participants will learn hands-on firearm and archery safety from certified, patient instructors. After you become familiar with the guns and bows available to shoot during the course, you will head out to the shooting ranges for one-on-one target shooting lessons. There will be a variety of shotguns, compound bows and crossbows. We'll wrap up the day with a lesson in gun cleaning.



No experience is necessary and all the equipment - bows, firearms, ammunition, targets, ear and eye protection - will be provided. This workshop is designed for beginners but also appropriate for anyone who wants to brush up on their shooting skills, or try a gun or a bow that they have not had the opportunity to shoot before.

This is an excellent opportunity to learn to shoot in a safe environment with the support of other women

The workshop will be held at the Bill Cook Chapter of the Izaak Walton League property and Conservation Center located just east of Stevens Point. The grounds consist of 147 acres of managed forest with the scenic Plover River passing through it. The large Conservation Center offers meeting space, a stone fireplace and modern restrooms.
