Join us for a full-day, hands-on introduction to small game hunting—with the help of trained hunting dogs! This workshop is designed for beginners who want to learn how to hunt rabbits, squirrels, and other small game with confidence.

Before the event, participants will complete a virtual class covering small game biology, habitat, and hunting regulations. During the in-person workshop, you'll get instruction on firearm safety and practice shooting small bore rifles. We'll cover scouting tips, hunting seasons, and how to work with hunting dogs in the field.

After a morning of learning and practice, you'll head into the field with an experienced mentor and trained dogs for a guided small game hunt. No experience is needed and all equipment is provided.

This is an excellent opportunity to learn how to harvest your own food in a safe environment with the support of other women and mentors!

The property offers a mix of forests, wetlands, and open fields - perfect habitat for small game like rabbits and squirrels. With well-maintained trails, shooting ranges, and a nature center classroom, Sandhill is an ideal spot for both learning and practicing hunting skills in a safe, natural space.
