



## Learn to Hunt Wild Turkeys, 2026

April 1, Virtual Classroom, 5:30-7:00 PM  
April 4 Field Day, Stevens Point, 10:00-4:00  
April 11-12 Actual Hunt, Central WI



**April 1, Virtual class:** 5:00-7:30 pm. Learn about turkey biology, habitat, behavior, and history; safety, seasons, and regulations; introduction to gear and guns.

**April 4, Field Day:** 10:00-4:00 Review firearm safety, eye dominance, range rules; Hands-on target shooting; ammunition basics; field dressing a bird; scouting, preparing for the hunt. Chili and bread provided for lunch, BYO snacks and beverages (no alcohol allowed).

**April 11, Welcome and Orientation:** 4:30-8:30 pm at the Wisconsin Lion's Camp. First time hunters will be paired with an experienced hunter who will offer guidance and support during an actual **Turkey Hunt! on April 12.**

Registration is \$199. Dinner and lodging on April 11 included.

The course is limited to 12 students who have never had the opportunity to hunt turkeys. No experience or equipment necessary. Guns, ammunition, gear provided. You will be required to complete an online hunter safety course (if you don't already have hunter safety certification), and attend the virtual class and the field day in order to participate in the hunt.
