



Are you interested in fire? Do you want the opportunity for hands-on experience in prescribed burning and wildland firefighting? Consider registering for the Spring Wildland Firefighter Course hosted by the WI DNR and the UWSP Fire Crew. By taking this two-weekend course you'll receive the basic certifications necessary to qualify as a Firefighter Type 2 (FFT2). Registration forms can be downloaded from our SPIN page or picked up from the red bulletin board across from the Fire Crew office(361A). Registration forms and the course payment of \$150 can be turned in at the Fire Crew office or mailed (see poster for details). The last day to register and pay for the course is February 17th.
