

UWSP 2025 Field Course Highlight: Trip to Lake Superior -Natural Resources, Culture, Climate Change


Students and Faculty were given the opportunity to learn about the importance of Ojibwemowin in partnership with the Greater Lakes Indian Fish & Wildlife Commission.


