



PFAS Education Workshop

On April 3rd at UWSP, a workshop about Perfluoroalkyl and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances (PFAS) was co-hosted by Dr. Seyed Javad Amirfakhri. The workshop, offered in both in-person and virtual formats, aimed to provide educators with instructional tools and resources to effectively teach PFAS-related topics to students in grades 6–12. A total of 24 educators enrolled in the workshop from numerous locations across WI and MN.

To promote engagement and active learning, the workshop included five interactive classroom-ready activities: K-W-L Activity (Know, Want to Know, and Learned Chart Activity).

- 1. Exploring prior knowledge and new learning
- 2. PFAS Scavenger Hunt Identifying PFAS in everyday items
- 3. Debate Exploring different perspectives on PFAS regulation and responsibility
- 4. Case Study Investigating a real-world PFAS contamination scenario
- 5. Game-Based Learning Reinforcing key concepts through a quiz-style game
