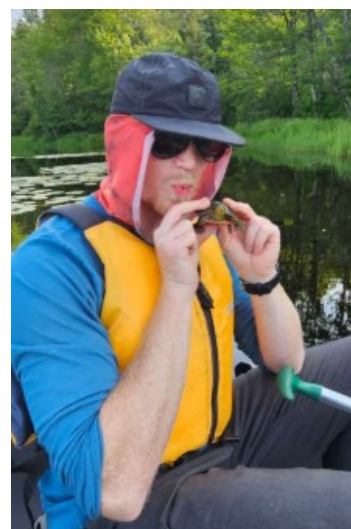

Deagan is currently working on a research project with Dr.

Artur Stefanski using spectroscopic analysis to look at the concentration of an EAB resistance phenol in the phloem tissues of Green and Blue Ash. Another recent project he led was a buckthorn pulling event out in Schmeeckle where they pulled about 700-800sqft of buckthorn and replanted a variety of sedge grass in its place.

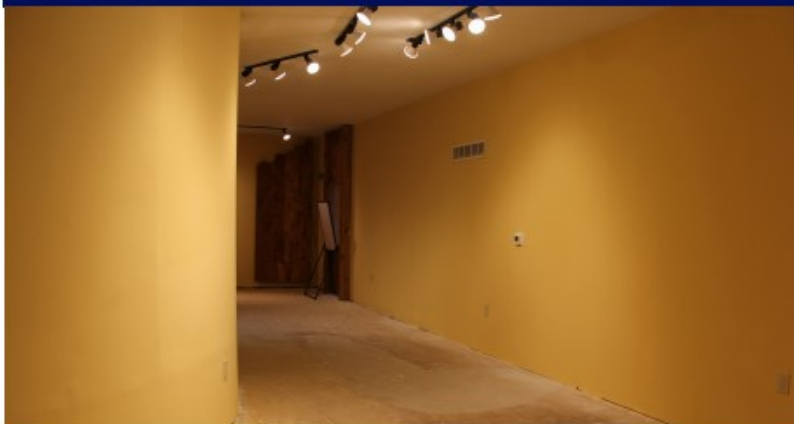

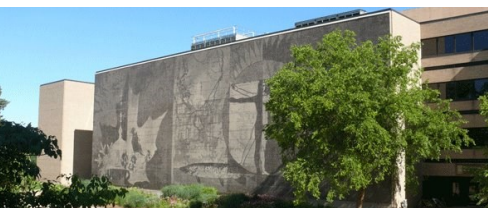
