My research focuses on plant ecophysiology and how future climate conditions may influence tree growth, survival, stand dynamics, and how that might influence silvicultural practices. I am particularly interested in integrating cutting-edge technologies into ecological and forestry research, including the use of hyperspectral reflectance and other advanced sensing tools

I am also partnering with Dr. Tiller on a new burn-research initiative that will have a unique setup, allowing us to integrate cutting-edge methods to advance our understanding of fire ecology and its applications in forestry.

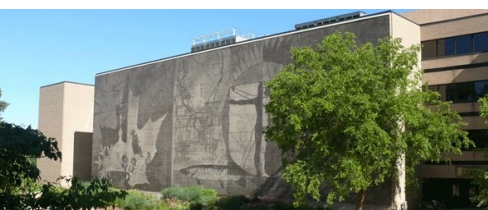
