Interested in agriculture? Join UW Madison Extension for Crop Scout Training Field Day. This in-person training compliments online resources on the basics of crop scouting available [here](#). The hand-on field day will be hosted on Tuesday, May 19th, 2026, from 10am – 2:30pm at the Rock County Farm in Janesville, WI.

This training will cover completing crop scouting reports; soil sampling; stand assessment and crop growth staging for corn, soybean, wheat, and alfalfa crops; the basics of collecting sweep net samples in alfalfa; and early-season insect and weed identification. Registration for the field day is \$50 per person and includes lunch plus a suite of scouting resources and tools.

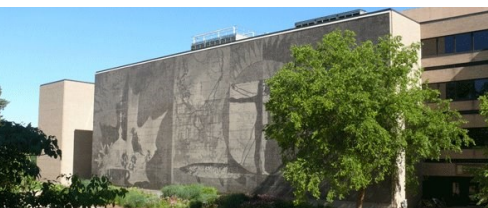
