Q: Will I be able to use my Financial Aid to help pay for my study abroad trip?

A: Yes! Federal, state, and most institutional financial aid may be used to help pay for a study abroad program at UW-Stevens Point, as long as you are a degree-seeking student, enrolled at least part-time (six credits) and meet all eligibility requirements.

## \*\*YOU MUST BE ENROLLED IN AT LEAST 6 CREDITS IN ORDER TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR FUNDING FOR A SUMMER, FALL OR SPRING STUDY-ABROAD PROGRAM\*\*

### Please follow these steps:

- 1. Submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov and promptly complete any subsequent tasks if required.
- 2. Submit a study abroad application to the Office of International Education for your desired program.
- 3. Accept your preliminary financial aid through accesSPoint.
- 4. Submit the Study Abroad Financial Aid Revision form to Financial Aid and Veteran Services.
- 5. Grant Financial Aid Pay Permissions through Student Financial Services. Review steps here: https://www.uwsp.edu/SFS/Pages/accesSPoint-Quick-Tips.aspx
- 6. Secure alternative funds as needed. For assistance with finding a private educational loan, you may consider viewing our online comparison tool, FastChoice https://choice.fastproducts.org/FastChoice/home/392400/1.

Upon confirmation of your participation in a study abroad program from the Office of International Education, we will adjust your cost of attendance to include the costs of your specific study abroad program. Revising your cost of attendance does not alter your expected family contribution (EFC), which ultimately determines eligibility for grant funding. In most cases, a study abroad revision may increase federal Direct Loan eligibility if not already awarded the maximum. The federal government has limits on the amount of Direct Loan funding a student may receive each year. These annual limits are listed below:

### Winterim Programs

Winterim study abroad programs differ from summer, fall, or spring programs. The winterim session is not considered a standard term that can be funded separately with financial aid. For financial aid purposes, winterim is attached to the spring term, and the credits earned in Winterim are counted with the spring course load.

### **Alternative Funding Sources**

Students frequently seek alternative funding sources to help pay for the expenses not covered through their financial aid package. Alternative funding sources can include personal savings, a private educational loan through a lender of your choice, or your parent may consider taking out a parent PLUS loan.
