Academic Standards and Policies for this Major: To be approved for graduation with a major in psychology, you need a minimum cumulative GPA or 2.25 in all courses taken on psychology, whether or not you declare academic bankruptcy. Transfer students must meet this requirement by having at least a 2.25 cumulative GPA in the total major and at least 2.25 cumulative GPA in psychology courses taken at UWSP.

*No more than 6 credits of 200-level courses will count toward psychology electives for the major.
