Walking several miles in a day is common but can be avoided via subways and taxis. Most Broadway theaters are not ADA compliant and will require steep stairs to get to our seating. New York subways also have steep stairs. Most of the shows are approximately five blocks from our hotel in which our group will be walking to. You are welcome to get an Uber/Lyft/Taxi (anytime during the trip) at your own expense and/or to request ADA seating in the orchestra when registering for the trip.
