Levels of care for every need

Outpatient

In outpatient locations throughout the U.S., participants engage in a concentrated, individualized treatment program for a portion of each day. We offer two levels of specialized outpatient care:

- Partial hospitalization care (PHP): 6 to 7 hours per day, 4 to 5 days per week
- Intensive outpatient care (IOP): 3 to 4 hours per day, 4 to 5 days per week

Inpatient

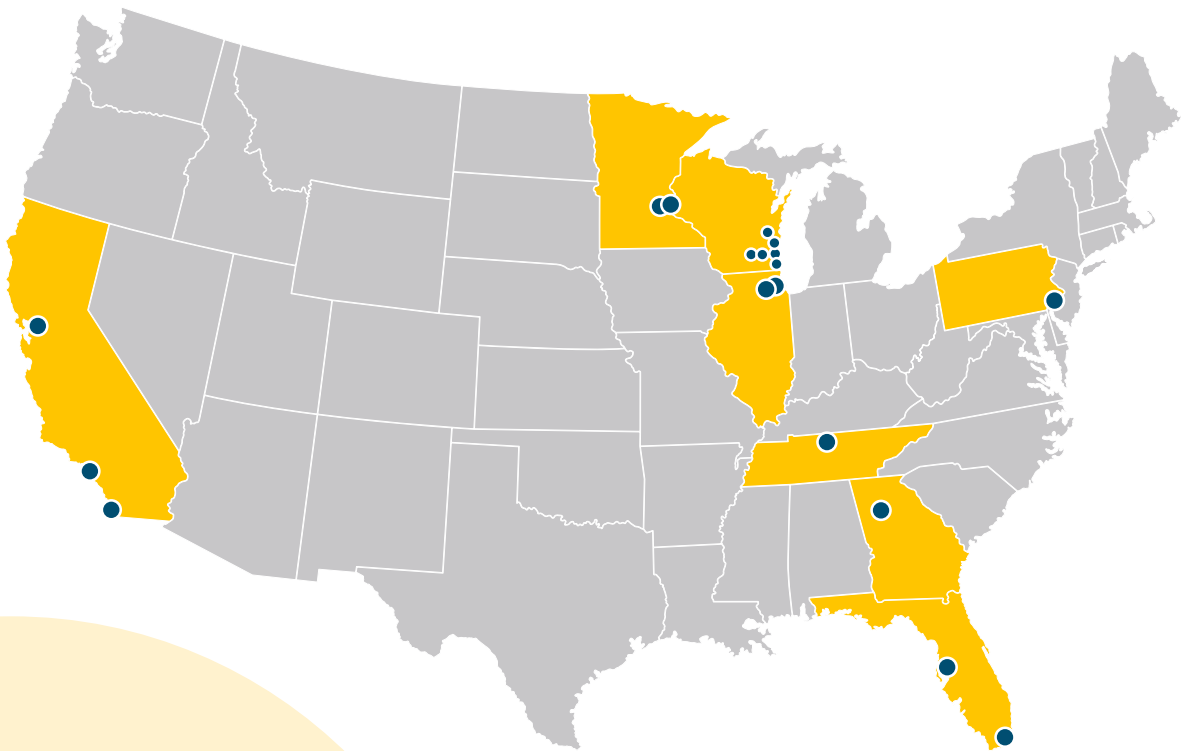
In crisis situations, we provide around-the-clock care, seven days a week at hospitals in Brown Deer, Oconomowoc, and West Allis, WI. Rogers offers separate units for children, teens and adults, as well as specialized, dedicated units for withdrawal management (detox) and nutritional stabilization.

Residential

With long-term stays and intensive daily therapy, residential care allows patients to focus exclusively on recovery in the safety of a controlled setting and build a solid foundation before returning to life's daily challenges.

Residential care located in Wisconsin:

- Addiction and Mental Health Recovery (separate programs for adolescents and adults)
- Focus Depression Recovery (separate programs for adolescents and adults)
- Nashotah Center for DBT (female adolescents)
- OCD and Anxiety (separate programs for children, adolescents, and adults)
- Eating Disorder Recovery (separate programs for adolescents and adults)
- Trauma Recovery (adults)
