- Cano Island Tour and Snorkling
  - Isla del Caño consists of approximately 200 hectares (500 acres) and lies 15 kilometers offshore.
  - Just a few meters from the white sand beach you will find creatures ranging from angelfish to the occasional small reef shark. This tour lasts all day and includes a picnic lunch and snorkeling equipment.
  - Dinner included.

- Visit <u>Hacienda Baru National Wildlife Refuge</u> to go hiking in the 330 hectares (815 acres) of tropical rainforest, mangrove, wetlands, river bank, and beach front. This wide variety of ecosystems means a high level of biodiversity, and that is why bird watchers have sighted over 365 species on the refuge.

- Farewell dinner at Bougainvillea Hotel.
