 - Medical debt, missing services, avoiding care

Complications for Kids

- Health Needs Change
 - Specialists
 - New diagnoses
- Age Transitions → New rules
- Income Changes
 - Job change → Insurance change





Putting out Fires

- Insurance Denial
- Referral Hotline, several places to call
- Phone tag
- Rapid deadlines
- Work with ABC for Health Advocate
- Issue mostly resolved, drift away
- Can anyone relate?



Health Benefits Check-Up Model

- Like preventive medicine, but for health coverage!
- Look at whole picture
- Keep record of key changes and transitions
 - Income
 - Health needs
 - Age



Health Benefits Check-Ups

- When to Check-Up? Who is this for?
- Complex Needs
 - Complicated medical condition
 - Split households/blended families
 - Kids with different needs in same household
 - Mixed immigration status families
 - Language barriers
 - Varying sources of income



Goals

- It's complicated, but with some help very doable!
- Improve advocacy strategies
- Stay on track with health benefits check ups
- Find trusted helpers!




Current Project

Check-Ups in Action

- Birth: NICU, CEN Coverage
- Age 4: missed milestones
- Age 5: Katie Beckett
- Age 8: Mom new job
- Age 12: lose Katie Beckett
- Age 14: Income decrease; BadgerCare+
- Age 16: maximize benefits!
- Age 17: apply for SSI
- Age 20: move to college
- Age 24: get job, lose SSI



Our Experiences


- Health Benefits Check-Ups with clients
- *Mindy's Story
 - Family of 4
 - 2 kids on BadgerCare+
 - One child's coverage wasn't "working" sometimes

*All client names and identifying information have been changed



Jasmine's Family

- Jasmine is a busy mother of 7
- Fluctuating Income
- Three of the children have special health care needs



- Kids ages 10 − 22
- 18 year old on IRIS, siblings paid for care

Clark's Family

- Family of 3
- Mom and child have significant health needs
- Large medical debt, some insurance denials
- Priority: insurance denial & financial assistance
- Later: income change, reevaluate coverage
- Next: Medicaid Unwinding



Update: Medicaid Changes

- Who? All Medicaid Programs!
- History
 - Families First Coronavirus Response Act (2020)
 - March 2020 present: continuous eligibility
- April 2023 May 2024: Unwinding Period
- Tips:
 - Update address and contact information
 - UTILIZE coverage!
 - Watch for notices



Update: Medicaid Changes

- Renewals 45 day notice
- Katie Beckett
- CLTS
- SSI
- BadgerCare+ Extensions



Advocacy Tip: Track Changes

- Stay organized and get help!
- Health Needs
- Income
- Household Size
- Address
- Insurance (including key dates!)
- Transition Ages
- We are working on FirstCheck WI as a tool to help families stay organized!

- What type of information do you think is helpful to share?
- Notes
- Questions
- Needs
- Space to think and talk freely



Benefit Check-Up Success Stories: Julie's Story

- Mom of 18 year old, Ryan
- Health Benefits Check-Up
- Keep BadgerCare+ under continuous eligibility
- Issue: graduated high school
- Outcome: add in IRIS, adult day programs



Benefit Check-up Success Stories: Gabriel's Story

- Married father of 2 year old,
 Ezra
- Health Benefits Check-Up
- Ezra on BadgerCare since birth
- Issue: Not aware of BadgerCare Renewals
- Outcome: Explored options, made a plan for the renewal





Action Steps

- Make a plan for tracking changes
- Note any upcoming transitions
 - Medicaid renewal?
- Contact ABC with questions
- Say It Forward
