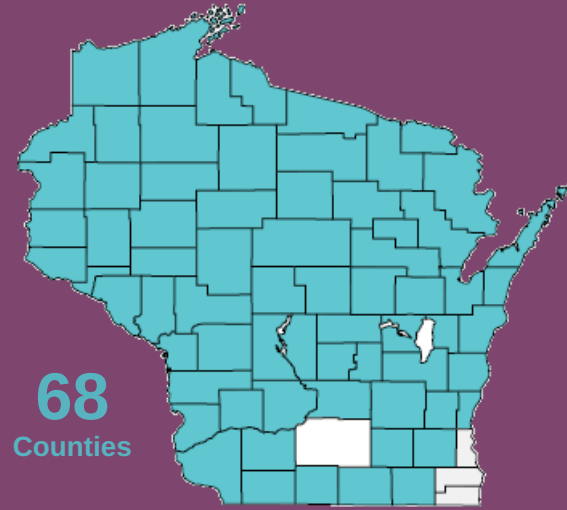

Family Care is a publicly-funded long-term care program where you can receive services and supports to help you live the life of your choosing.

How does it work?

1. Visit your local **Aging & Disability Resource Center** and find out if you are eligible for long-term care services.

2. If eligible, the Aging & Disability Resource Center staff will tell you about the options available.
3. If you enroll in Inclusa, a Health & Wellness and Community Resource Coordinator will become part of your care planning team that includes you and anyone else you choose.
4. You and your team will develop a plan to help you reach your goals.
5. You and your team will meet and decide which supports and services will help you reach your goals.
