Location: The outer south wall of the Daniel O. Trainer Natural Resources Building (TNR) A UWSP art professor designed the mural, the largest of its kind in the country. It contains 286,200 different tiles and is roughly half the size of a football field. The project began in 1972 and concluded in 1982. It is entitled, in the words of our nation's motto, "E Pluribus Unum" – "From Many, One." The photos composed in the mural represent the four colleges at the university, the university insignia, as well as our state fish, flower and bird. In the center, there is also a map of the Wisconsin River system.

Visit the Museum of Natural History to see our exhibits, augmented reality sandbox and our fish tank full of piranhas!

The natural history exhibits are supported by 25,000 sauare feet of collections storage and research space containing over 400,000 specimens from ten scientific disciplines. Our permanent exhibits consist of a series of large biologic dioramas depicting environments from around North America, as well as Africa.





#### Schmeeckle Reserve— Take a hike!

**Location:** You can enter the reserve from Maria Drive on the north end of campus, about a 10 min. walk from Chemistry Biology Building (CBB) or MCCH. Trail Hours: Sunrise-Sunset

Schmeeckle Reserve is a 280 acre conservancy on the campus of UW-Stevens Point, set aside to protect natural communities of central Wisconsin. It is open to the public and serves as a picturesque gathering place for the community and university. Explore five miles of trails and boardwalks, a 24-acre lake and a large diversity of habitats that support numerous wildlife species. The reserve is managed by the College of Natural Resources to protect and restore ecosystems, serve as an outdoor classroom for learning and provide outdoor recreation opportunities.

#### Schmeeckle Visitor Center

Location: 2419 North Point Drive, Stevens Point **Hours:** 9 a.m. - 4 p.m. (Friday) 10 a.m. - 4 p.m. (Saturday)
