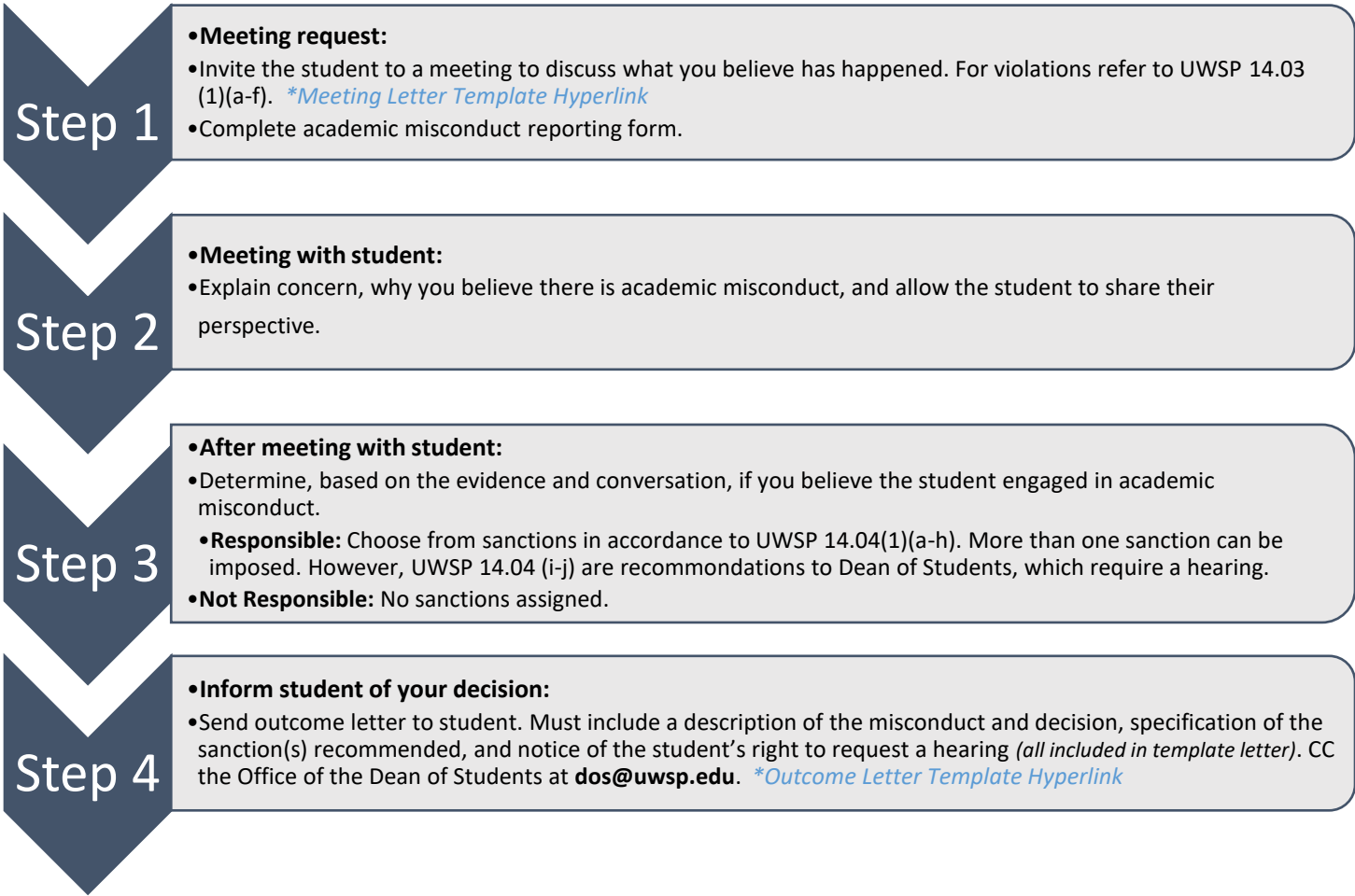


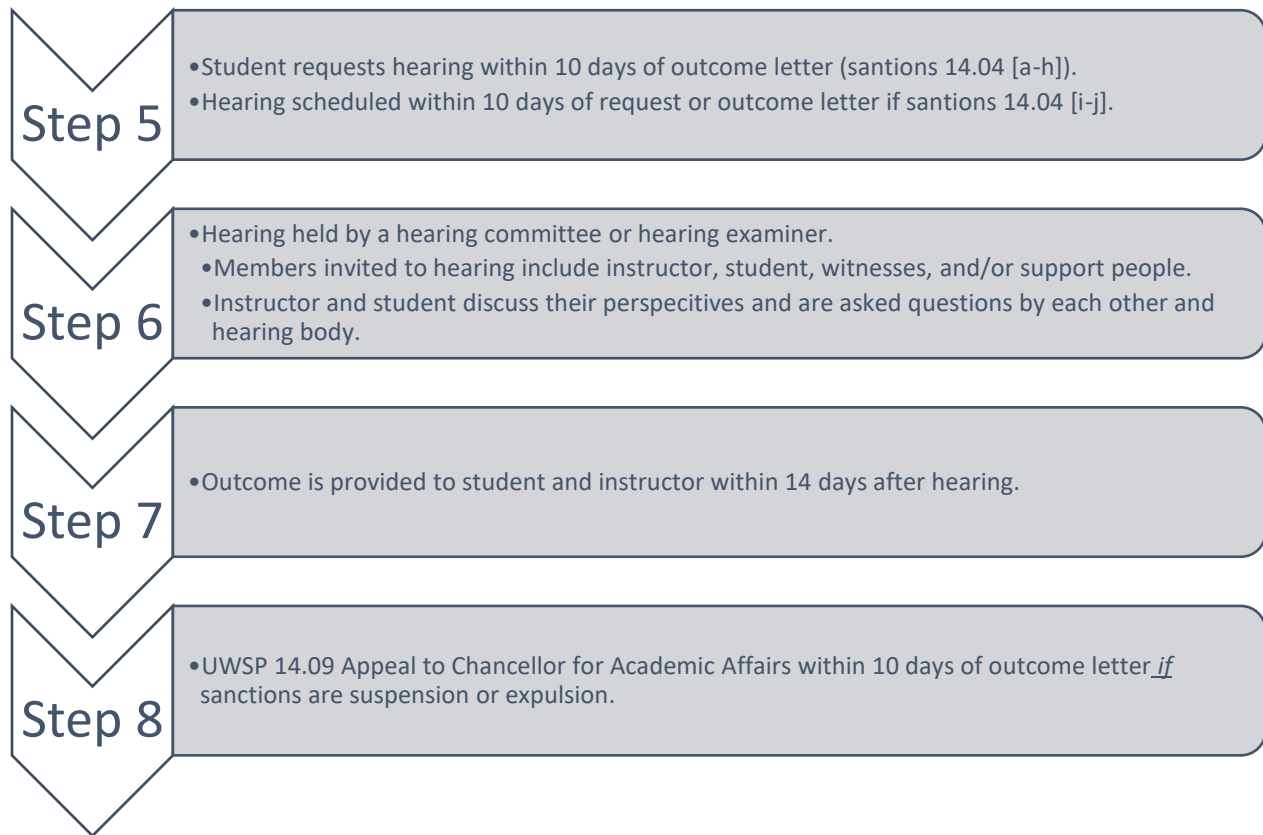
UWSP Ch. 14.06 Academic Misconduct Procedure Guide



Academic Misconduct Violations	Sanctioning
<p>UWSP 14.03 (1)(a-f):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Seeks to claim credit for the work or efforts of another without authorization or citation; b. Uses unauthorized materials or fabricated data in any academic exercise; c. Forges or falsifies academic documents or records; d. Intentionally impedes or damages the academic work of others; e. Engages in conduct aimed at making false representation of a student’s academic performance; or f. Assists other students in any of these acts. 	<p>UWSP 14.04 sanctions a-h:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. An oral reprimand (<i>warning</i>) b. A written reprimand presented only to the student (<i>already happens with outcome letter</i>) c. An assignment to repeat the work, <u>to be graded on its merits</u> (<i>cannot take points off new work based on previous assignment-or average both grades</i>) d. A lower or failing grade on the particular assignment or test e. A lower grade in the course f. A failing grade in the course g. Removal of the student from the course in progress h. A written reprimand to be included in the student’s disciplinary file <p>-----</p> <p>Refer the case to the Dean of Students:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <i>*i. Disciplinary Probation</i> <i>*j. Suspension or Expulsion from the University</i>

UWSP Ch. 14.08 Academic Misconduct Hearing Procedures

...Steps continued when a hearing is requested or required



Preparing for a hearing:

- **Prior to hearing:** Instructor will be asked for explanation of facts (written outcome)
- **Prior to hearing:** Instructor and student will be asked for any evidence used to make determination in outcome (course work, etc).
- **During hearing:** Instructor and student have an opportunity to present their position on the case and ask and respond to questions.
- **During hearing:** Instructor and student may present witnesses.
