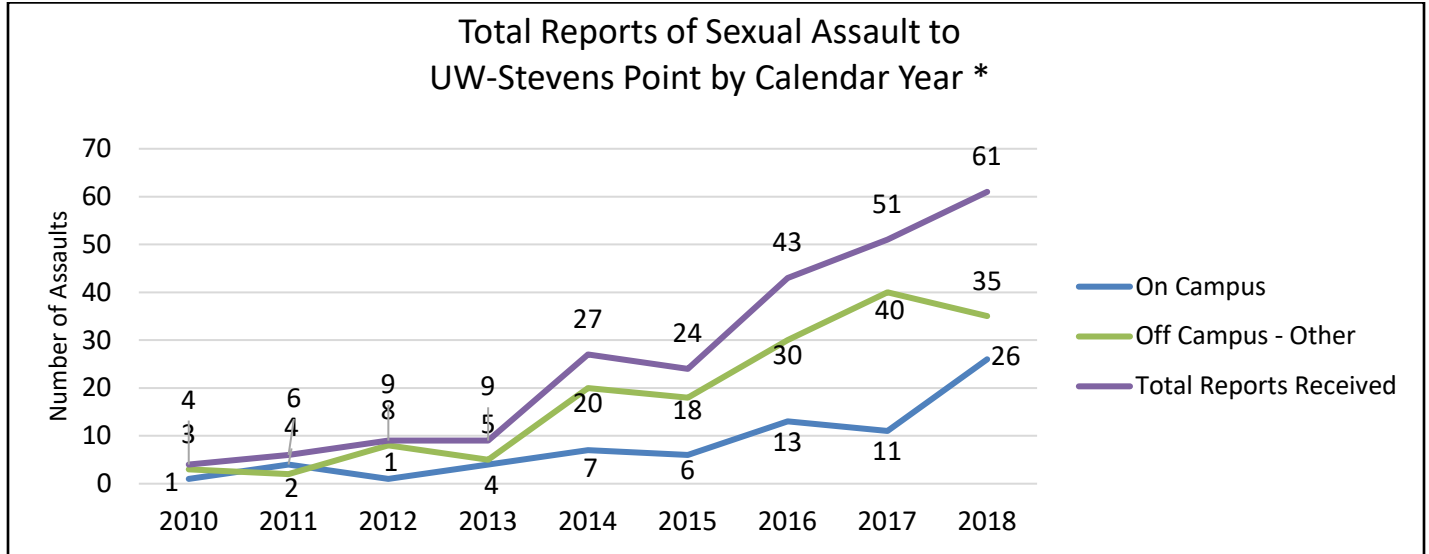


Sexual Assault Reports Summary

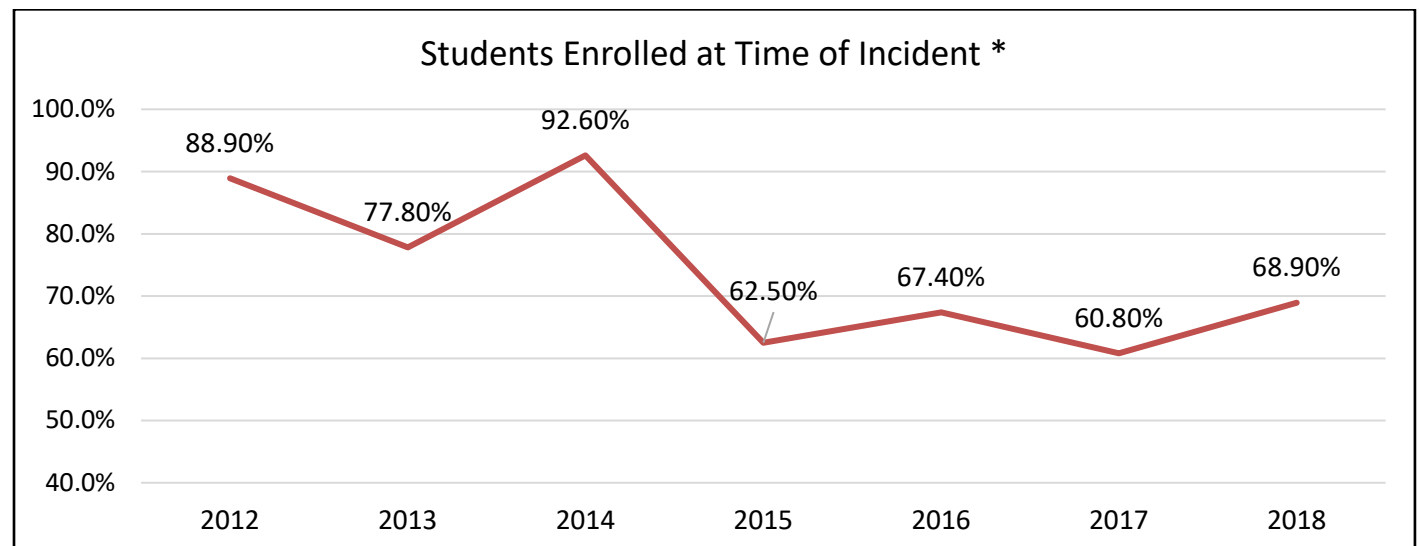

Wisconsin Statute §36.11(22) requires UW System schools to submit an annual report of sexual assault data and campus best practices. The statistical portion of the report requires institutions to submit the number of reports, to include information about the location of the assault, connection between those involved (acquaintance, stranger, unknown), degree of assault as defined by Wisconsin law, and whether or not alcohol or drugs were used by either party, if known. The narrative portion of the report asks institutions to share the two or three best examples of institutional initiatives designed to prevent sexual assaults and support to survivors of sexual violence.

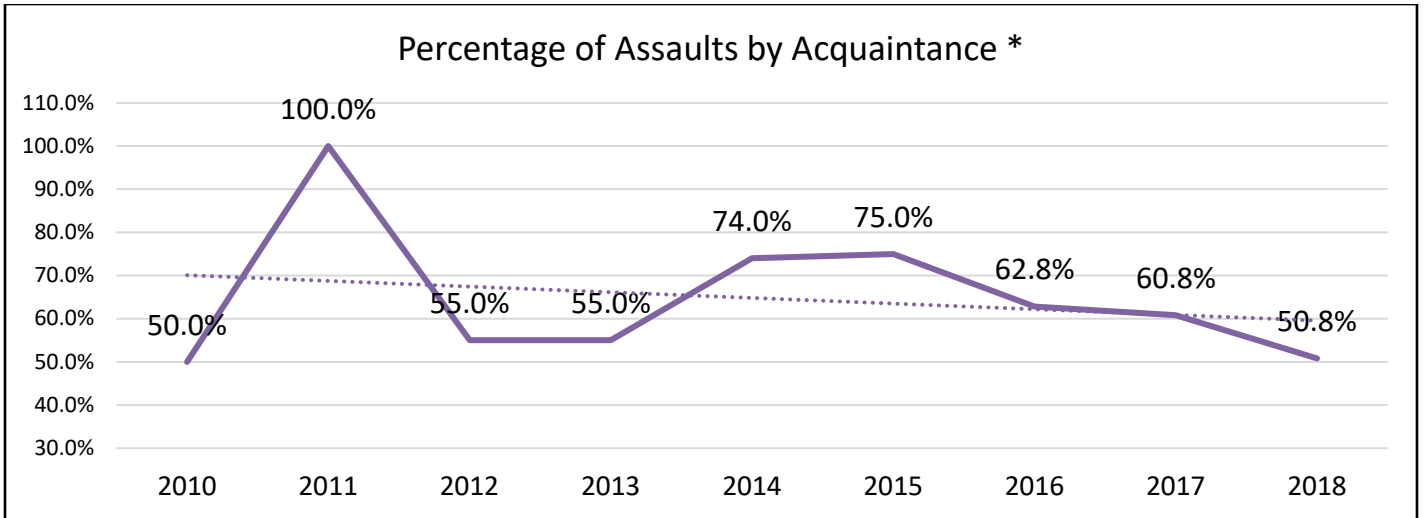


* Not all reported assaults occurred when the victim was at UW-Stevens Point. In 2018, fifty-nine (59) reports came from the Stevens Point campus and two (2) reports came from the branch campuses of Wausau and/or Marshfield.

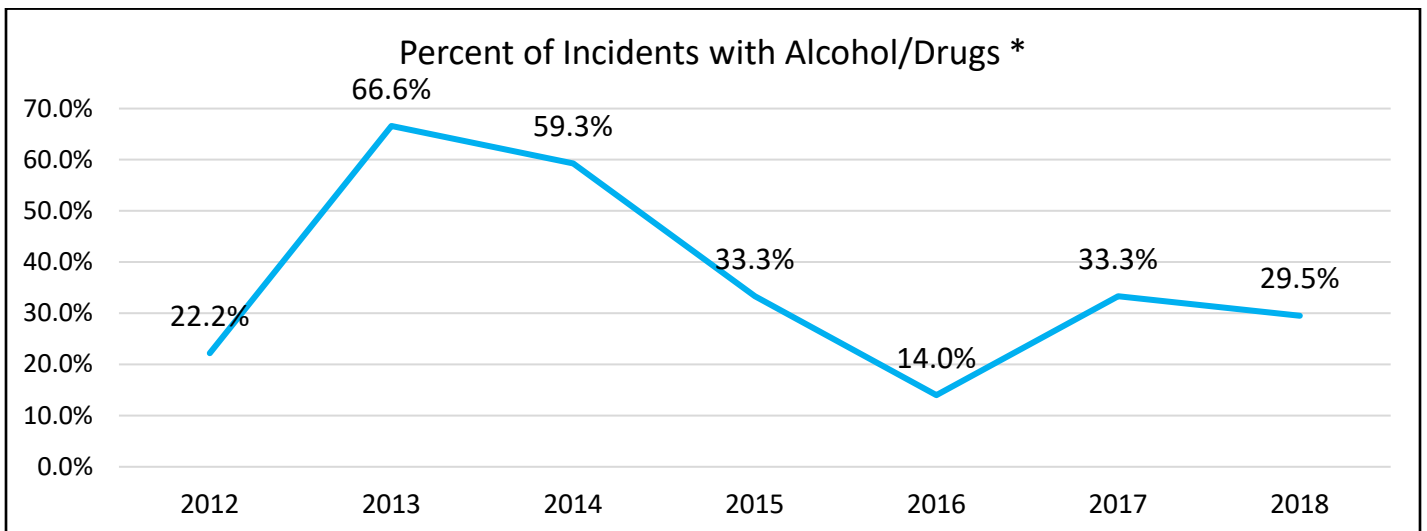
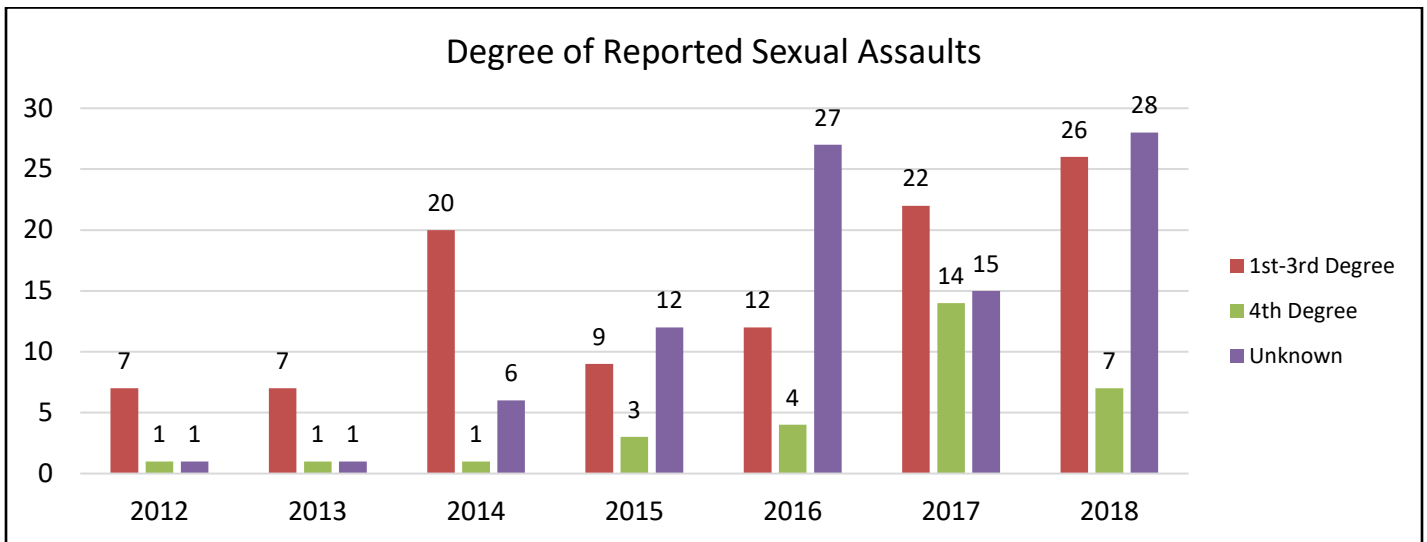
The *Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act* requires that institutions of higher education annually publish the number of reported sexual assaults, among other crime statistics. Note that the *Clery Act* **only** requires schools to report crimes that occur **on University owned or controlled lands**. This number of reports is twenty-six (26) for calendar year 2018.



* In 2018, forty-two (42) of the reported incidents occurred when the victim was enrolled as a student at UW-Stevens Point. Of sixty-one (61) total reports, 36.1% (22) did not identify the victim/were submitted anonymously.



* In 2018, twenty-two (22) reports do not indicate the connection between the individuals involved and eight (8) indicated a stranger committed the assault.



* Of the 61 reports submitted in 2018, eighteen (18) reports indicated that alcohol or drugs were used by one or both individuals involved. Thirty-five (35) submitted reports did not include an answer to this question.
