

University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point Alcohol and Other Drug Use Profile Spring 2017

Heavy alcohol and drug use is a national problem on most college campuses. At UWSP, heavy alcohol use is a problem for small percentage of our students, but NOT a problem for the majority of our students. Here is a profile of our most recent survey results.

In February 2017, the Center for Prevention administered an alcohol and other drug use survey to 1500 randomly selected students. 516 students (34.4%) completed the survey.

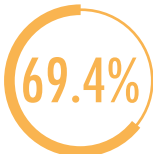

of students do not drink alcohol

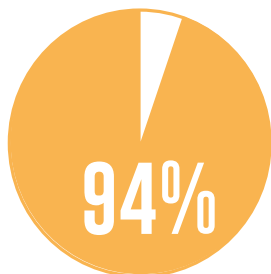


of UWSP students drank alcohol before coming to campus

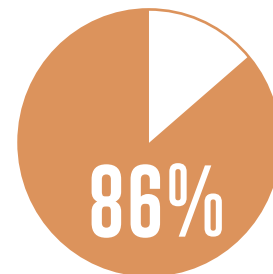


of students drink 5 or fewer drinks when they party

Alcohol Use & Sex

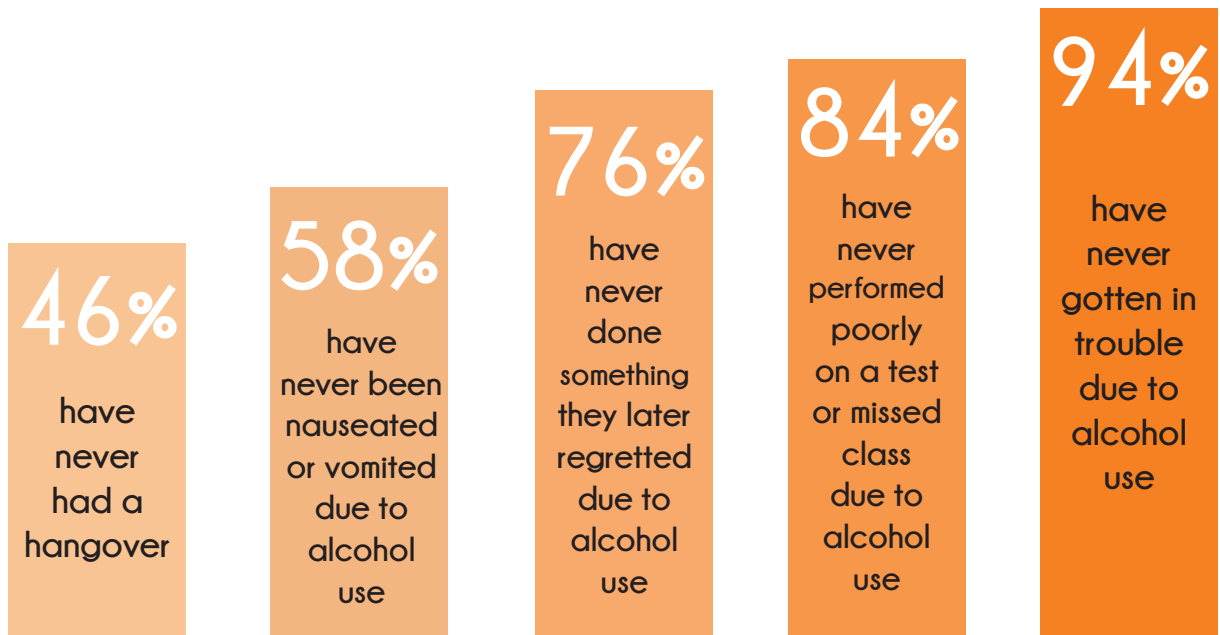


Have not experienced

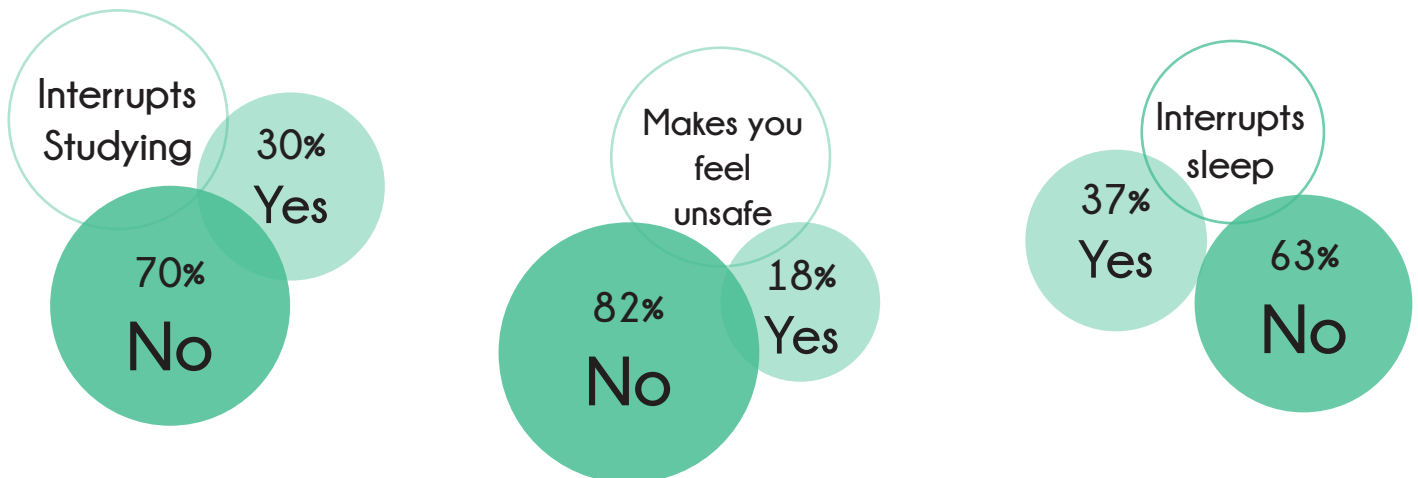


Indirect Consequences of Alcohol Use

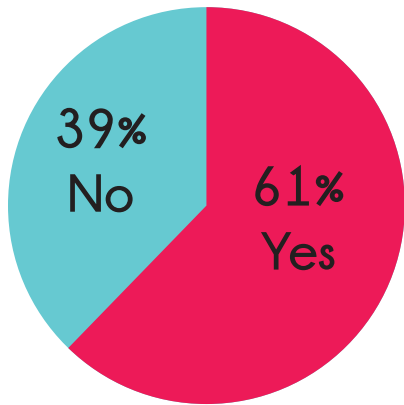

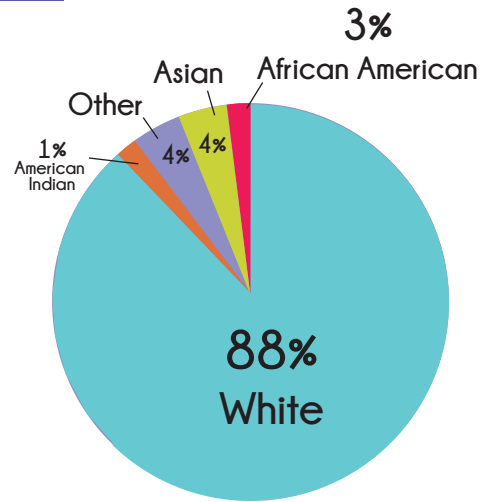
In which of the following ways has drinking by other students interfered with your life on or around campus?



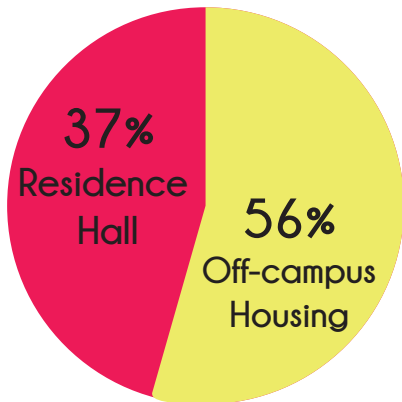

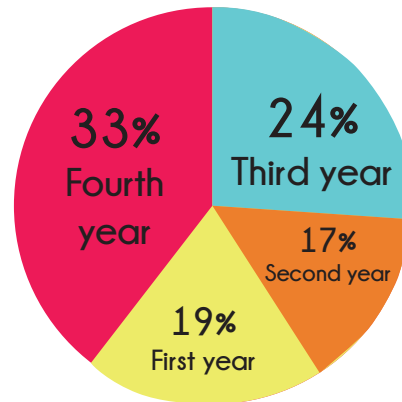
Are you currently of the legal drinking age?



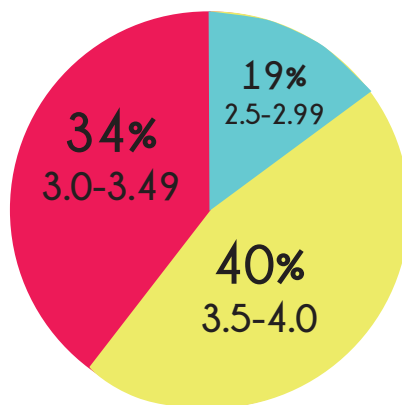
What racial or ethnic groups do you mainly identify with?
