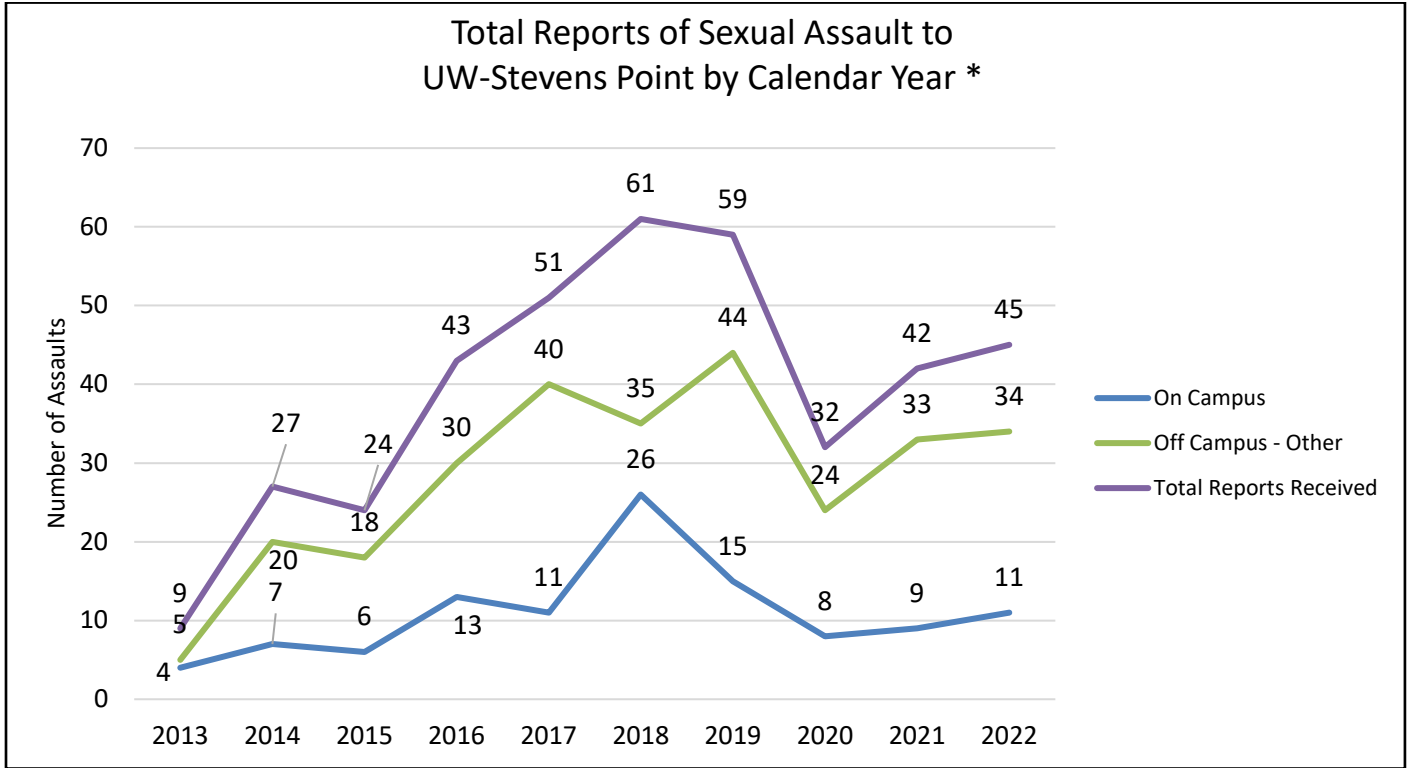


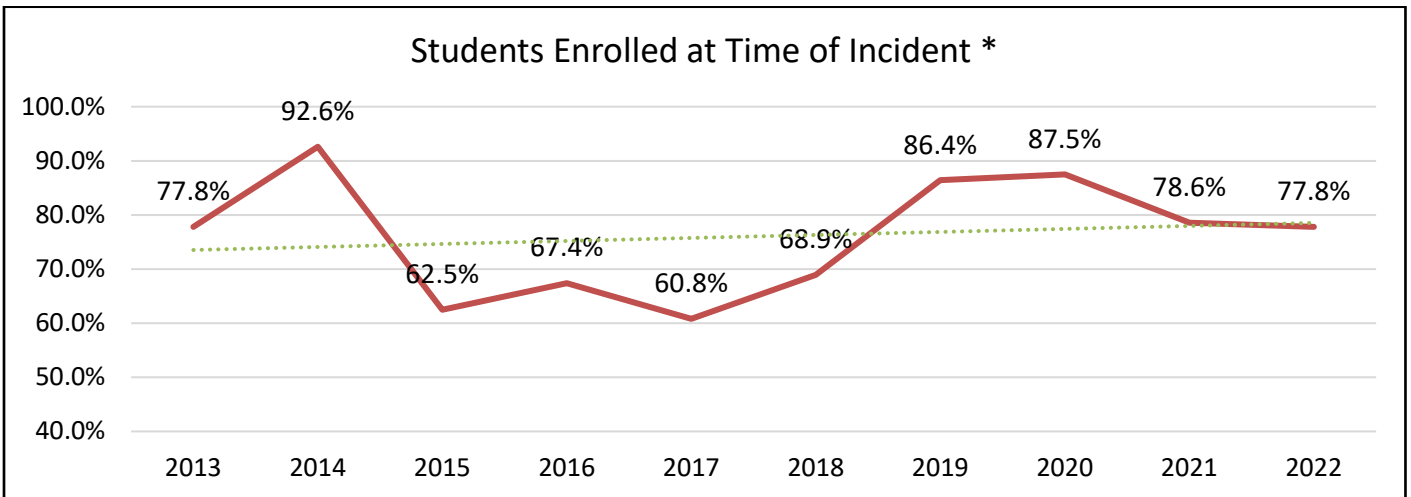
# Sexual Assault Reports Summary

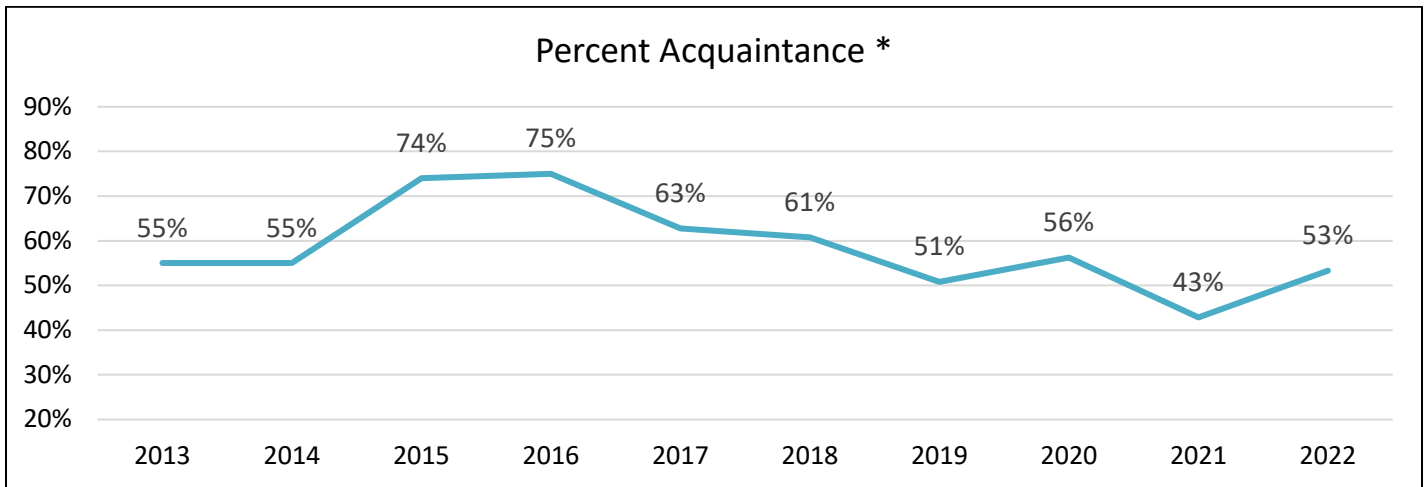
Wisconsin Statute §36.11(22) requires UW System schools to submit an annual report of sexual assault data and campus best practices for the previous calendar year. The statistical portion of the report requires institutions to submit the number of reports, to include information about the location of the assault, connection between those involved (acquaintance, stranger, unknown), degree of assault as defined by Wisconsin law, and whether or not alcohol or drugs were used by either party, if known.



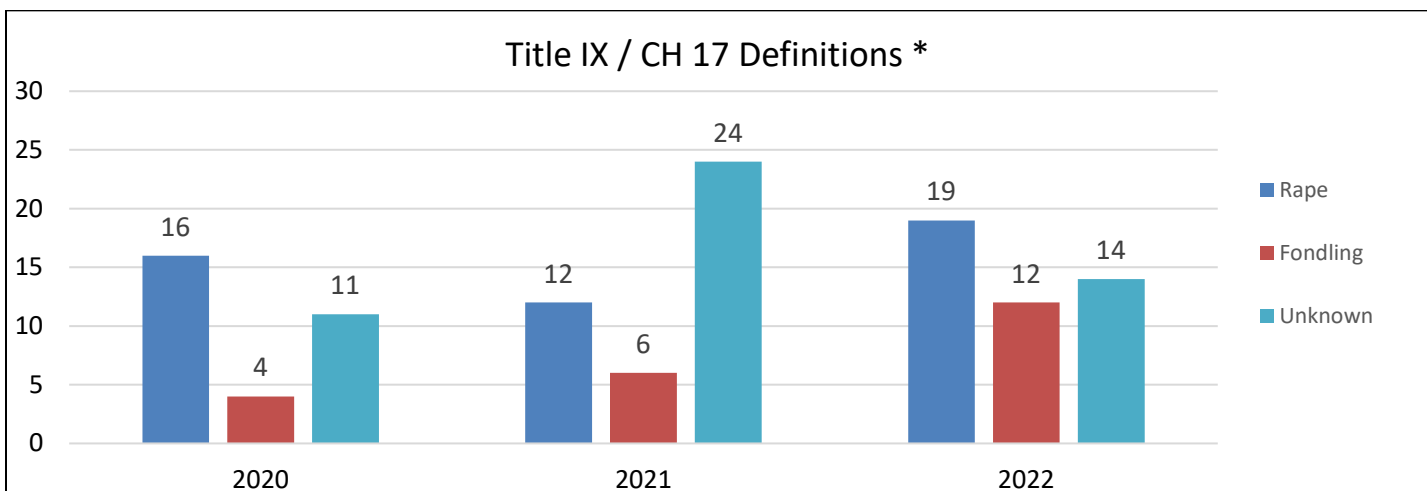
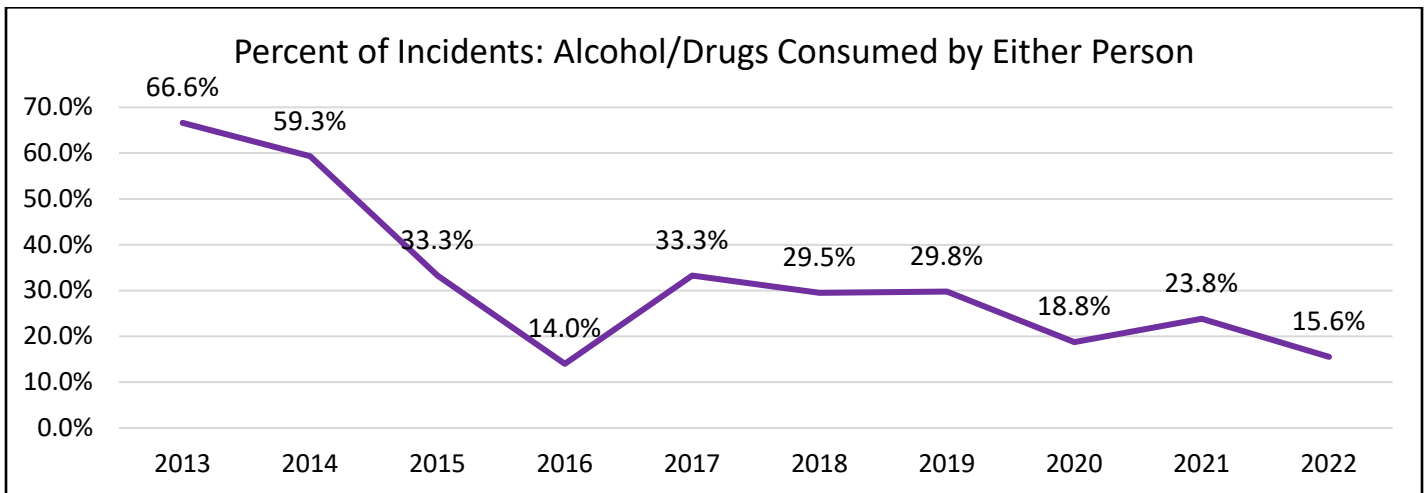
\* In 2022, forty-five (45) reports came from the Stevens Point campus and zero (0) reports came from the branch campuses of Wausau and/or Marshfield.



\* Not all reported assaults occurred when the victim was at UW-Stevens Point. In 2022, ten (10) of the 45 reported incidents occurred prior to when the victim was enrolled as a student at UW-Stevens Point.



\* Of the 45 incidents reported in 2022, one (1) was reportedly committed by a stranger and twenty (20) reports did not indicate the relationship between the two persons. Twenty-four (24) reports indicated an acquaintance or significant other relationship between the two parties involved.



\* Definitions under Title IX and in Chapter 17 – Student Nonacademic Disciplinary Procedures were changed when the Department of Education issues new guidelines in 2020. “Unknown” represents reports where the type of incident was not selected, the narrative is insufficient to make a determination, or when the narrative only says, “sexual assault.” Rape and Fondling are both forms of sexual assault.
