To sign up for a volunteer position, please visit this link: https://forms.gle/senChryJQ33aY4USA All volunteers should anticipate arriving at 9am and staying until take down until 3pm the day of.</p> <p>We are looking for the following help with volunteering: Pre-Registration Check-In/Handing out t-shirts- Duties include set-up, greeting attendees, maintaining the pre-registration paperwork, organizing T-shirts to be handed out, manning the table during the event, and take down.</p> <p>New Registration Check-In (must be computer savvy)- Duties include set-up, greeting attendees, registering new attendees with provided laptops via Google Forms, manning the table during the event, and assisting with take down following the event.</p> <p>Help with people getting into and out of kayaks- Duties include set-up, transporting boats and equipment to the beach area, assisting attendees in entering and exiting the watercraft and using the adaptive equipment, as well as take down following the event. Volunteers must be able to lift 100lbs.</p> <p>Assisting people on the water in tandem kayaks- Duties include being in a tandem kayak on the water with attendees and monitoring the 25 minute time slots. Volunteers will be expected to assist with take down, clean up, and transporting both boats and equipment off the beach following the event. Volunteers must be strong kayakers.</p> <p>Water Safety- Volunteers will be stationed on the lake in kayaks to ensure attendees are staying within the parameters of the lake set by event planners, attendees are being safe and perform life saving efforts if needed. Volunteers do not need to have a lifeguarding background but is highly encouraged.</p>
