

Volunteer teaching summer experience

We are a non-profit childcare center looking for a student who would like to volunteer to do an outdoor summer program a couple days per week that would include, but is not limited to teaching children ages 3-8 about the outdoors and all of the things that live outside. This could be trees, animals, rocks, birds, bugs, plants, etc. The student may be able to use this as experience toward their degree. This experience would look great on a resume when looking for a permanent job.

Job description:

- *Plan a curriculum around the outdoors.

- *Implement that curriculum with different groups of children each week.

- *Along with the teachers, take each group of children out for ½ - 1 hr each week.

Teach 3 days per week for 2 - 2 ½ hours equalling 6 - 6 ½ hours per week.

The program would last 8 weeks.

Other:

Each group of children will have 2 teachers and 10-24 children. There will be 6 groups of children total, so plan for about 85 -115 children each week.
