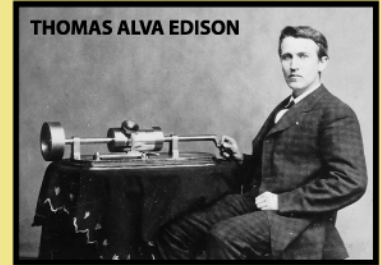

Q: What did the chilly seal say when it swam into a concrete wall?

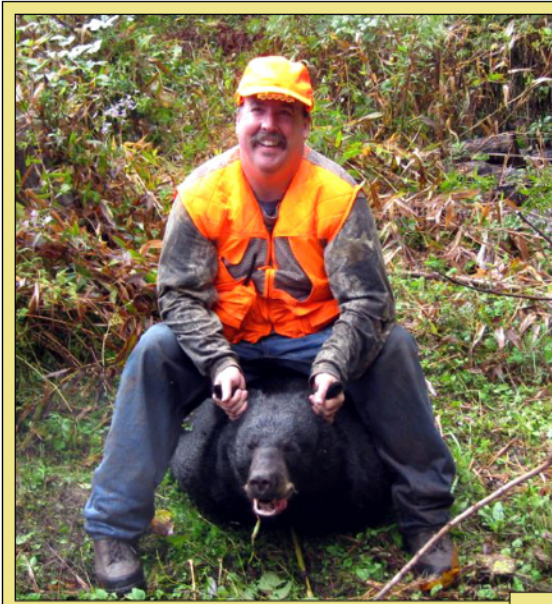

Building & Grounds Superintendent, Chris Brindley trapped this 60 lb. Wolf near Park Falls, Wisconsin this October during his first year of trapping.



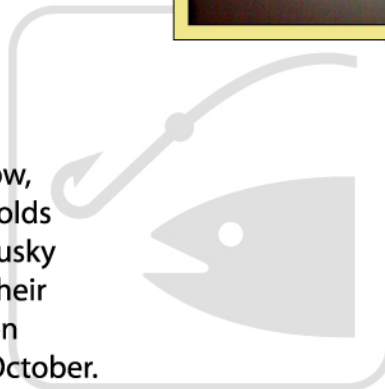
