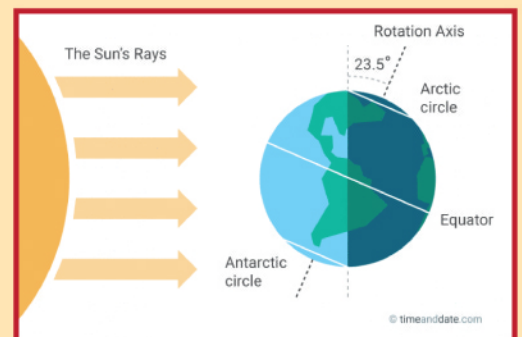

### December 22nd, 2015 The Winter Solstice:

This is the shortest day of the year in the Northern Hemisphere. The Sun is directly overhead of the Tropic of Capricorn in the Southern Hemisphere during the December Solstice.

The December Solstice occurs when the Sun reaches its most southerly declination of -23.5 degrees. In other words, when the North Pole is tilted furthest – 23.5 degrees – away from the Sun. In the Northern Hemisphere, it is the day of the year with the fewest hours of daylight.

On December 8th, 1980... former Beatle musician, composer and vocalist John Lennon was assassinated in New York City.

Did you know that John Lennon wrote 88 songs by himself for the Beatles? He also wrote 43 songs with fellow Beatle Paul McCartney, 2 songs along side Ringo Starr and 1 song with George Harrison. All this, before writing 54 songs as a solo artist.
