During the final weeks of October and the first week of November, the Facility Services Maintenance Work Unit erected a brand new bicycle shelter near the DUC.

Approximately 10 feet by 35 feet of existing concrete sidewalk was saw-cut and removed with the assistance of the Grounds Work Unit. Three new concrete piers were dug 4.5 feet into the soil and formed using plywood. The plywood forms were coated with bio-degradable form oil for ease of stripping and rebar cages where fabricated, welded and installed prior to the new concrete pour. Concrete piers where poured and anchor bolts where set. Pier forms where stripped and sidewalks were graded and compacted in anticipation of the sidewalk concrete pour. 4.5 yards of concrete sidewalk where then poured and finished. The new prefabricated bike shelter was erected and new bike stanchions where installed.
