DATELINE: JANUARY 8th, 1961

The baseball world mourned the death of 3-time all-star, **Lynwood 'Schoolboy' Rowe**. Rowe was given that nickname when he was just 15 years old, and already playing on a men's baseball club.

During a September 13, 1934, nationally broadcast interview on the Eddie Cantor radio show, Rowe asked his fiancee, "How'm I doing, Edna honey?" The line became famous, endearing 'Schoolboy' Rowe to women across the country, but it also led to relentless heckling from fans and opposing players, who enjoyed taunting him with his own words: "How'm I doing, Edna?" Rowe used to talk to the ball on the mound quite often which apparently led Yankee slugger Lou Gehrig to say "That's the strangest fella' I've ever faced."


## ONE HUNDRED YEARS AGO DATELINE: JANUARY28th, 1915

The William P. Frye, a four-masted steel barque built in Bath, Maine, in 1901 and named for the well-known Maine senator William Pierce Frye (1830-1911), was on its way to England with a cargo of wheat. On January 27, it was intercepted by a German cruiser, the Prinz Eitel Friedrich in the South Atlantic Ocean off the Brazilian coast and ordered to jettison its cargo of wheat as contraband. When the American ship's crew failed to fulfill these orders completely by the next day, the German captain ordered the destruction of the ship.



FIFTY YEARS AGO **DATELINE: JANUARY 1st, 1965** 

During a massive storm featuring 70+ mile-per-hour winds, the **SS Catala** runs aground near Ocean Shores, Washington. After several attempts to refloat her, the **SS Catala** becomes a local attraction, known as the "**Tilting Ship**". In 2007, and after a costly oil remediation program, the Catala is cut into pieces and removed, restoring the site where it laid for 42 years.


## Winters can be fierce in Wisconsin...
