


A sculpture created by University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point 3D art major Riley Fichter has been installed at the Stevens Point Sculpture Park.

Riley Fichter, of Baraboo, submitted a striking 10-foot sculpture titled "Weight/Agony." It debuted Saturday, June 11, at the Stevens Point Sculpture Park's Summer Celebration.

Staff at UW-Stevens Point and community members also helped make the installation a reality, including **Eva Hathaway from Facility Services - Central Stores** on campus. A local rock company donated the limestone slab that is the base. The city provided use of a bulldozer.

The 20-acre Stevens Point Sculpture Park features artwork from local, regional and national artists. Five pieces are added each year and remain for three years, so the park is always growing and changing. Nestled in a wooded area at 900 North Second Street, the Sculpture Park connects to the Green Circle Trail's Brickyard segment. Parking is available along North Second Street or in the Zenoff Park lot.
