Position Summary	The UWSP Student Health Service (SHS) provides primary outpatient health care services to the diverse population of UWSP students. Clinical staff members share a commitment to high quality medical care and serving the unique needs of students. Providers assess, diagnose, and provide treatment to students presenting with primary care needs and mental health concerns in an outpatient setting. This position is 16 hours per week (0.4 FTE), specific schedule TBD but will be during SHS operating hours of 7:45-4:30 M-F during the academic year (September-May) and does not require after-hours or on-call coverage. The Advanced Practice Mental Health Provider provides a wide range of mental health care to students with a focus on prevention, patient education and health promotion. The individual in this position will work collaboratively with Student Health Service provider staff, providing consultation as requested, and will be available for consultation with Counseling Center staff. Successful candidates will have experience and expertise in working with young adults from diverse backgrounds and will work well independently. Advanced Practice Providers work with departmental staff, consultants and multiple university departments to support student health. Title will be determined at the time of hire per the candidate's professional designation. Candidates with diverse identities are encouraged to apply.
