***Friday, Feb. 2—Last day to Add a course and to Drop a course without a "W" grade

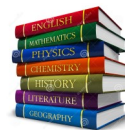
***Friday, Feb. 2—Tuition is Due! Or \$200 down payment for payment plan is due. Pay in PRISM

Visit the NEW **Chemistry Tutoring Lab!** Watch for more details about this new space and service!

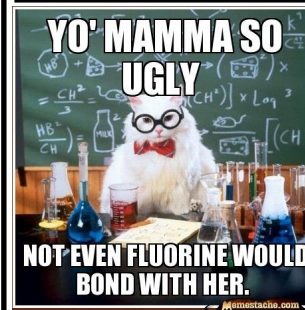

Stop by the library in February to guess the number of candy hearts in our display.

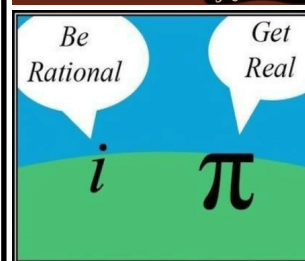
The winner will be announced towards the end of the month and will walk away with all the candy!
