My Dear Family -

Tonight I'll be sleeping under a blanket! This community is up in the "mountains" and the boy just brought a mosquito net and a blanket in to the room. This hotel is very plain but I should have a good rest.

There is a chance that the air plane will not fly tomorrow because of rain so we have arranged to take a "land rover" down to Cagayan de Oro - leaving here at 4 AM and taking 4 hours - it took us 25 minutes in the plane this afternoon - but we should be there in plenty of time to get our plane back to Manila.

The normal school here is in need of the most help of all the ones we have seen. The school was completely destroyed by the Japanese during the war they had to start all over. Also the leadership has been lacking and that makes a difference.

Tonight we had a wonderful Chinese driver - served by one of the girls who is graduating from the normal school in April. It would be wonderful to be able to offer her a scholarship - it only there was some way for them to afford the transportation to the U.S.

The flowers here are beautiful - more so than any where we have been - partly because of the altitude and partly because it is not as hot as other places.

This is short but I wanted a few minutes with you before retiring - to visit and to send to you my love -
