Situated on 100-acres, the Wood County campus is located in the heart of Marshfield, a community ranked as one of the best places to live and work, and home to one of the state's largest health care providers, Marshfield Clinic Health System. Campus amenities include the Everett Roehl STEM Center, opened in 2018 and featuring chemistry, microbiology and nursing programs, the 340-seat Helen Laird Theatre, which hosts university and community performances, and a 55-acre arboretum that provides students and community members a great way to explore rare vegetation that once covered central Wisconsin.

**Build a foundation
for success with an
Associate of Arts and
Sciences (AAS) Degree**

The AAS degree puts you on the path to a bachelor's degree and is transferable to institutions across the UW System. It provides you with a liberal arts general education and a breadth of intellectual and practical skills.

General Degree Requirements

1. You must complete a minimum of 60 credits to receive the AAS. At least 15 of the 60 credits must be earned at the institution's three campuses.
2. You must have a grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 earned cumulatively at the institution's three campuses, and a 2.0 overall GPA in credits applied to the AAS.
3. The AAS general education requirements must be fulfilled.

Apply

Apply for admission through the UW System Application as soon as possible after August 1. uwsp.edu/apply

Applicants should submit:

- High school transcripts*
- ACT or SAT scores (optional and self-reported)**

*Unofficial high school transcripts will be accepted for admission consideration.

Cumulative grade point averages can be self-reported.

**ACT and SAT scores are optional and self-reported for admissions consideration, but may be required for scholarship consideration.

Scholarship

Complete the scholarship application. Priority consideration will be given to students who have been admitted and submitted their scholarship application by December 15 and March 1 at <https://www.uwsp.edu/marshfield/admissions/Pages/scholarships.aspx>.
