# Overview

This report presents students responses to the *HIP Quality* survey administered during the spring of 2020 as part of your NSSE administration. Overall, 416 students at University of Wisconsin-Stevens Point responded to this questionnaire. The following tables detail your students' responses, disaggregated by the selected High-Impact Practice (HIP). If students selected more than one HIP, they were prompted to choose just one to respond about.

Kuh and O'Donnell<sup>1</sup> identified eight key elements that make these activities high-impact:

- Performance expectations set at appropriately high levels
- Significant investment of time and effort by students over an extended period of time
- Interactions with faculty and peers about substantive matters
- Frequent, timely, and constructive feedback
- Experiences with diversity wherein students are exposed to and must contend with unfamiliar people and circumstances
- Periodic, structured opportunities to reflect and integrate learning
- Opportunities to discover relevance of learning through real-world applications
- Public demonstration of competence.

This report is structured around those eight key elements, with each appearing in a unique section beginning with *High Performance Expectations*. Students could respond about HIPs in progress or about activities that were complete (see tables in the following section). To facilitate analysis, each section contains tables for all student responses, and responses among those whose HIP was complete, in separate tabs. Alternate question wordings for those whose HIP was in progress appear in [brackets]. Percentages may not sum to 100 due to rounding. All results are unweighted.
