

WHAT TO BRING TO COLLEGE

THESE ARE SUGGESTIONS TO CONSIDER WHEN PACKING

Adapt this list to suit your own situation. To save on packing, consider purchasing some items after you arrive to campus.
PRO TIP: It would be best to pack for one season at a time.

CLOTHING

- Belt
- Coats (winter and rain)
- Hats, gloves, scarf
- Pajamas, robe
- Shirts, sweaters, blouses, etc.
- Shoes, boots, sandals, etc.
- Shorts, pants, jeans, etc.
- Socks and undergarments

DESK SUPPLIES

- Computer, ethernet cable
- Notebooks, folders, binders
- Paper, binder clips
- Pens, pencils, highlighters, etc.
- Planner, calendar
- Rubber bands
- Scissors
- Stamps, envelopes
- Stapler, staples, staple remover
- Sticky notes, index cards
- Tape, tape dispenser

HOUSEHOLD ITEMS

- Bed sheets (twin XL)
- Blankets, comforter
- Mattress pad
- Pillow
- Towels, wash cloths, etc.

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS

- Debit card, cash
- Health Insurance card
- Photo ID, PointCard (student ID)
- Social Security card, birth certificate, passport (Needed when getting a campus job!)

KITCHEN ITEMS

- Can opener
- Dish soap, sponge
- Paper towels
- Utensils
- Water bottle

MISCELLANEOUS

- Alarm clock
- Bike with heavy duty lock
- Clothing hangers
- Disinfecting wipes
- Extension cords
- Fan
- Flashlight
- Headphones
- Laundry basket/bag
- Laundry detergent, dryer sheets
- Mini vacuum
- Umbrella

TOILETRIES

- Body, face soap
- Comb, hairbrush
- Cotton swabs
- Dental care products
- Deodorant
- Facial tissue
- First Aid kit
- Hair care products
- Hair dryer, curler, etc.
- Loofah
- Lotion, facial moisturizers
- Medications
- Nail clippers, tweezers
- Razor, shaving cream
- Shower caddy
- Shower sandals

SHARED ITEMS

(check with roommate)

- Area rug
- Coaxial cable for TV
- Coffeemaker
- Futon
- Microwave (1500 watts or less)
- Posters, art
- Refrigerator (no larger than 5.4 cubic feet)
- Smart speaker
- TV, gaming system, DVD player
